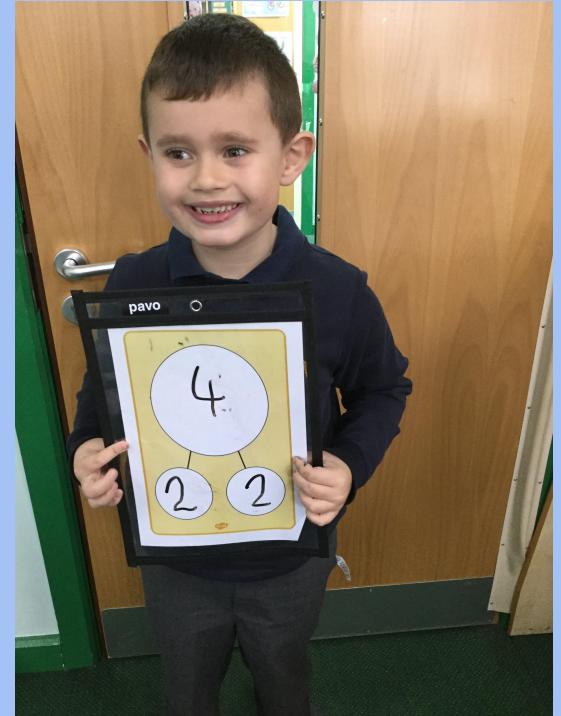
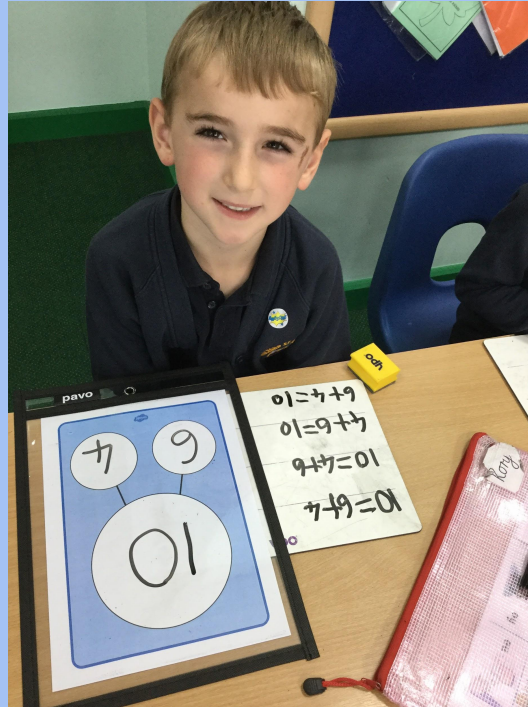
## **The World and I Autumn 1**

**In Y1 Maths, we have been learning to order numbers from the smallest to greatest and greatest to smallest number.**

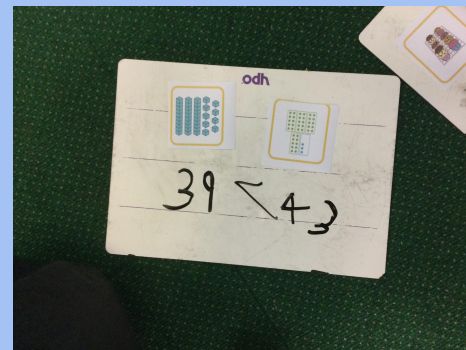
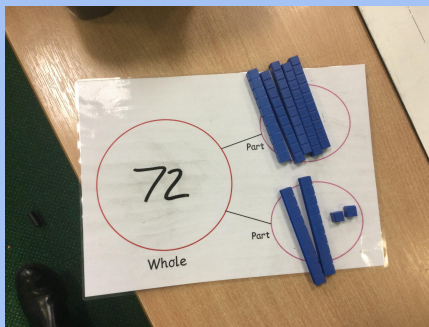
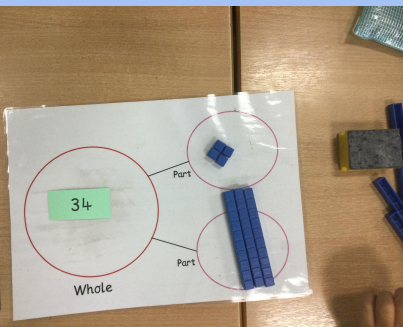


In Y1 Maths, we have been learning how to represent numbers in different ways.

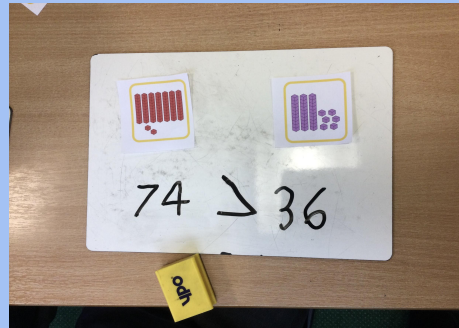




In Y2 Maths, we have been learning to read and write numbers up to 100. We have then learnt to order and compare numbers and objects.

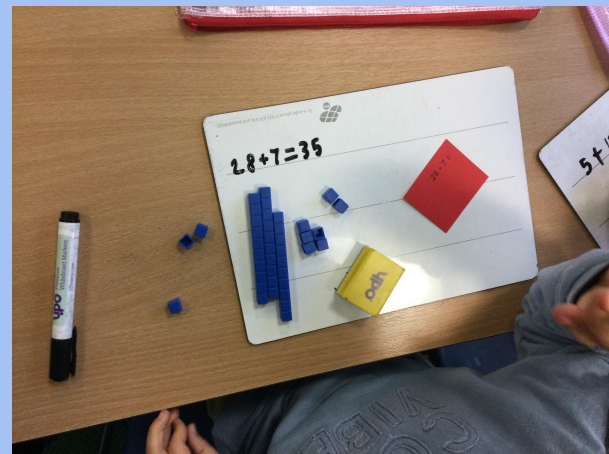
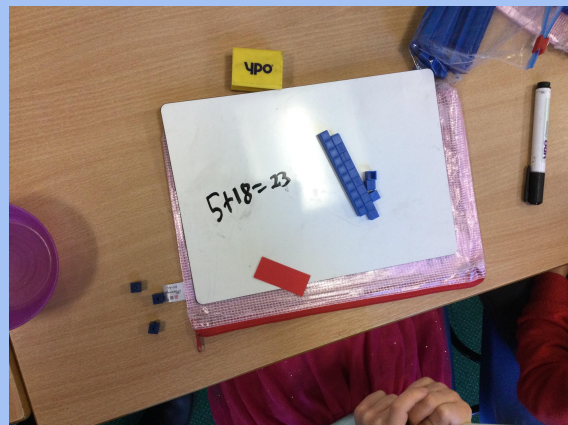
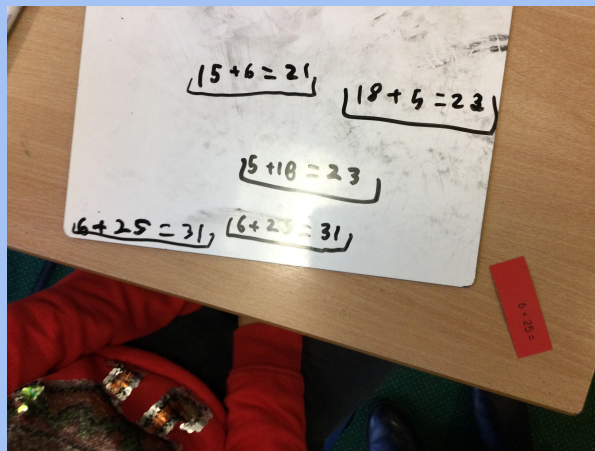


We learnt to partition numbers in different ways.

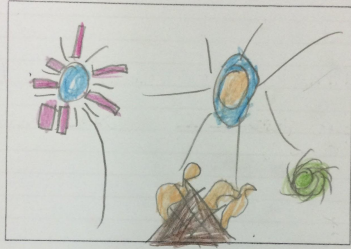

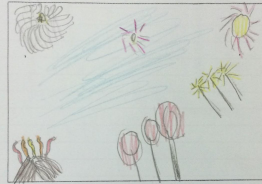

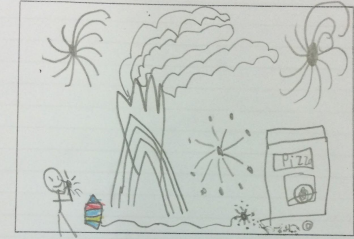

In science, we have been learning about the human body. We have learnt about the different senses, part of the human body and how to stay healthy.

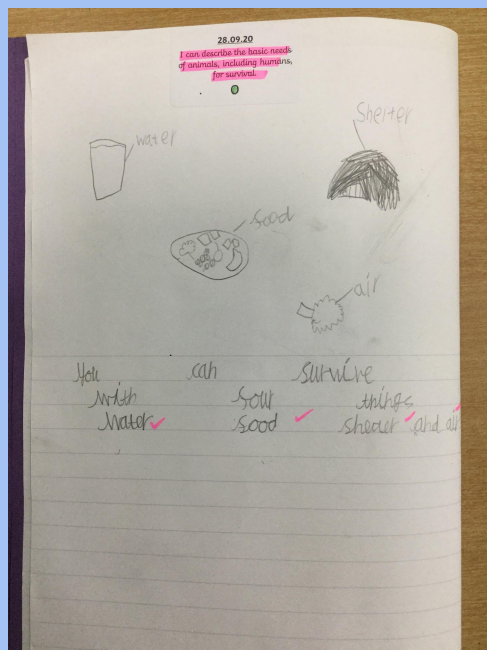


We learnt the names of the different parts of the human body. We drew an outline and labelled these.

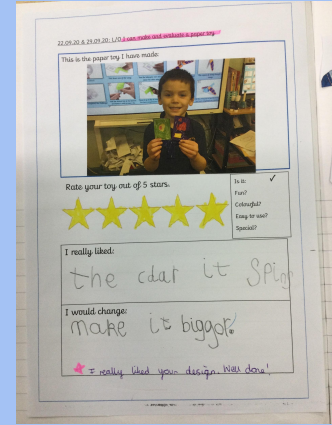
# In history, we have learnt about toys then and now. We also compared schools then and now. Then we learnt about Florence Nightingale and how she changed hospitals.



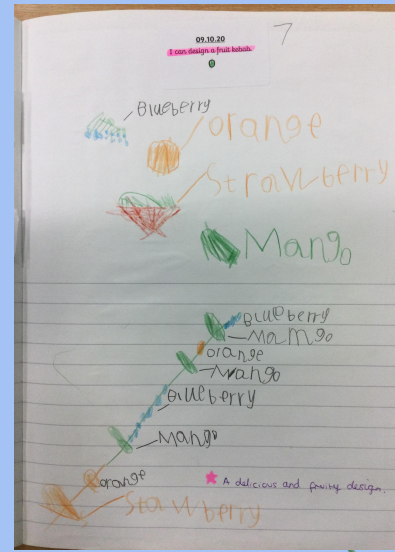
In DT this half term, we have designed and made paper toys. We thought about what makes a toy enjoyable and then created our own.
