


Come and see our wonderful learning during summer term.

We then read the story Jim and The Beanstalk. A Beanstalk appeared in our school car park. We wrote a newspaper report about this.


In English, we wrote our own instructions based on planting our own seeds in science.







YI Maths











In Y1 maths, we have been learning to partition, compare and order numbers.






We have also been learning about money. We learnt about position and direction. We used the key words: forwards, backward, clockwise and anticlockwise to direct our partners.



Muslims have 99 names for God. The names are found in the Qur'an and are often called the 99 Beautiful Names of Allah. Each name tells Muslims something about God.

It is important to remember that Muslims do not draw Allah - they use words to describe him. Not pictures.



The 5 pillars are:

- Shahadah = belief
- 2. Salah = prayer
- 3. Zakah = charity
- 4. Sawn = fasting
- 5. Hajj = pilgrimage

We are just going to be focussing on Shahadah and Salah.



We designed our own prayer mats. We had to remember Muslims do NOT draw pictures/images of Allah, Muhammad, other prophets, or angels and so out of respect to Muslims we cannot draw them either.






Relationships Health Education

- 6. Who can you speak to if you are worried or need help in school?



















Pirate Week
