
We wrote our own quest stories, after reading the books 'Journey' and 'Quest' by Aaron Becker.





Year 3 also enjoyed a team game to see how much water they could transport using sponges. They measured the water in their starting and finishing boxes and calculated the volume of water lost on the way!




Y4 enjoyed their work on Capacity!

SCIENCE




Observations






SPANISH

Saying sorry is really important when you have done something wrong.




