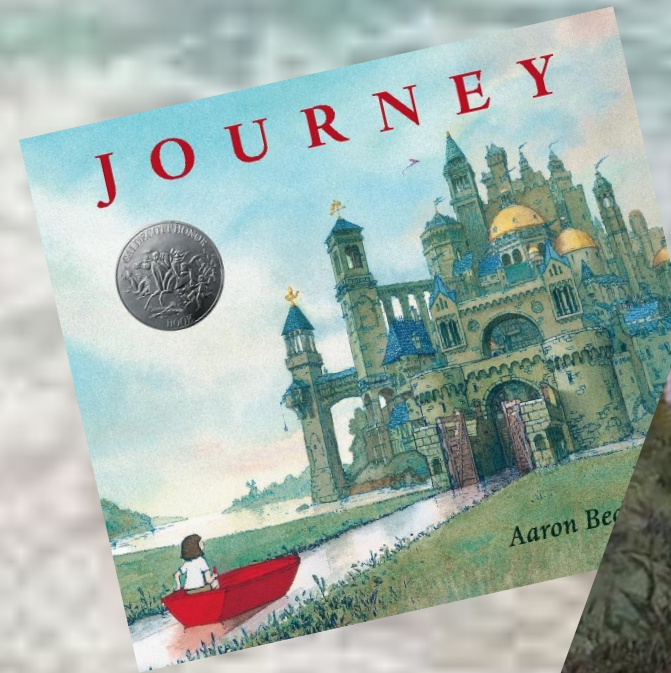

Some tips: there are five different animals. If you discover them you will get full power of the crayons. Beware of the Evil King, if you see any sight of him RUN!

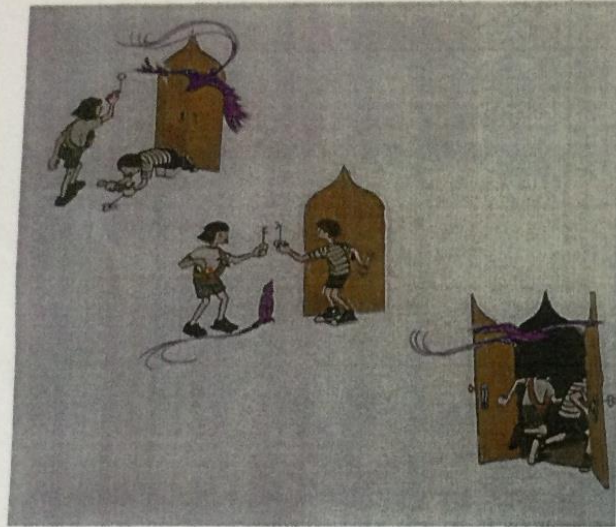

And as they went. SPLASH!

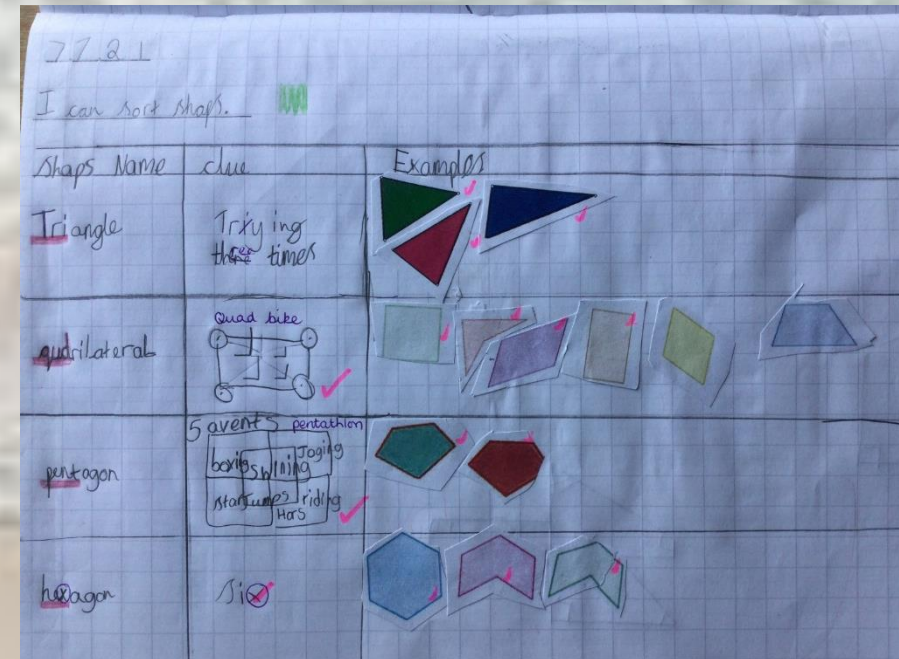
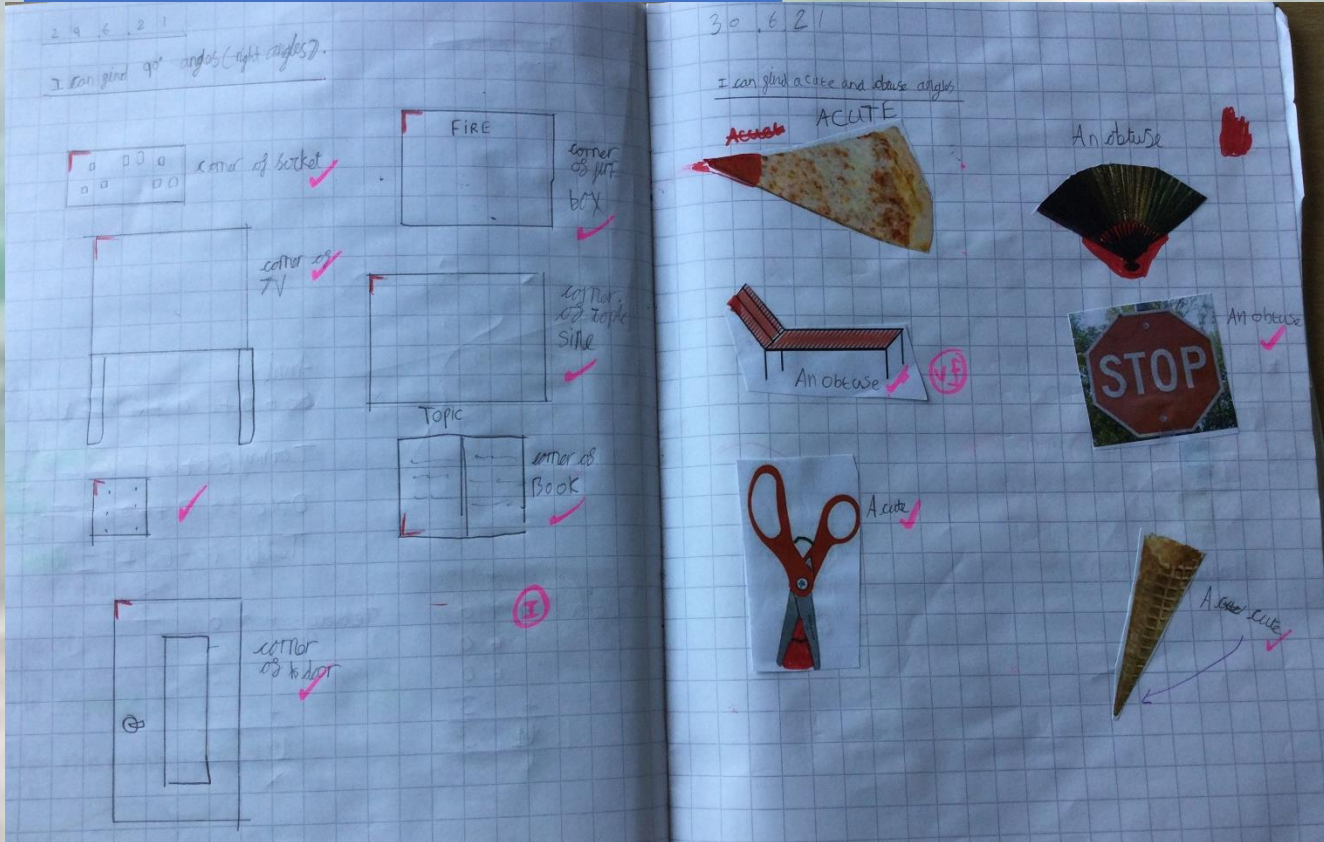
Excitedly, the children clung onto the, pretty purple squid. Nervously, they looked back and saw the guards zooming towards us.

In Maths, Year 3s have been finding angles in real life objects and thinking of ways to remember the names of some 2D shapes.



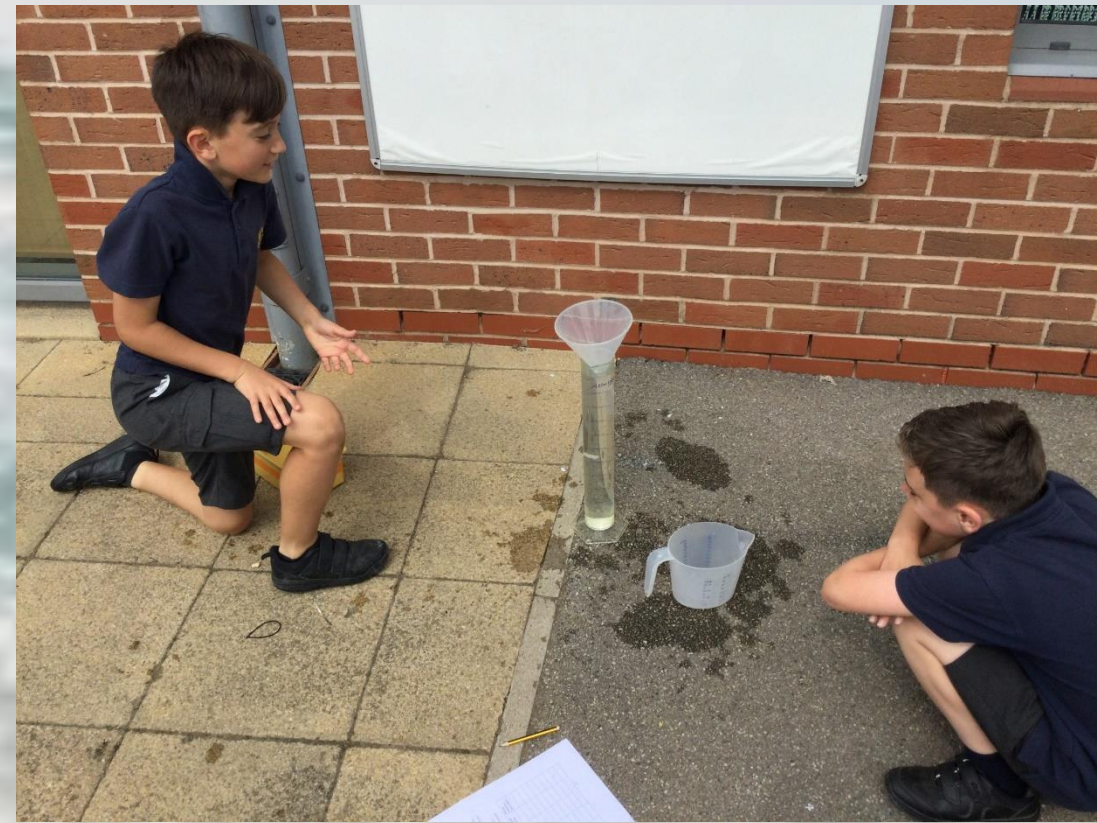


Year 3 also enjoyed a team game to see how much water they could transport using sponges. They measured the water in their starting and finishing boxes and calculated the volume of water lost on the way!





Y4 enjoyed their work on CapaCity!

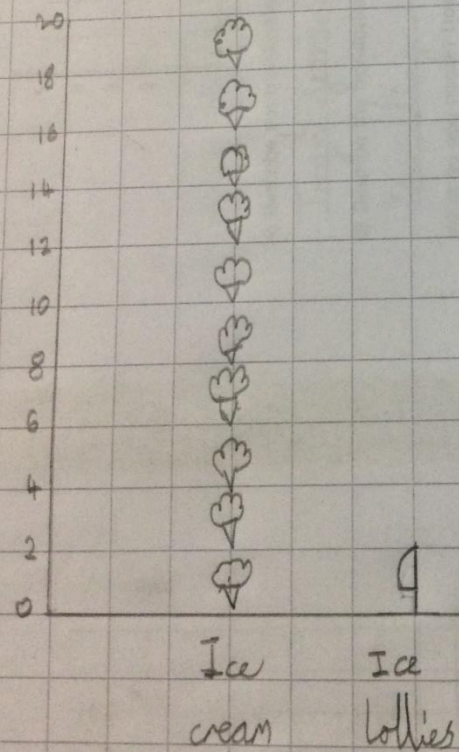








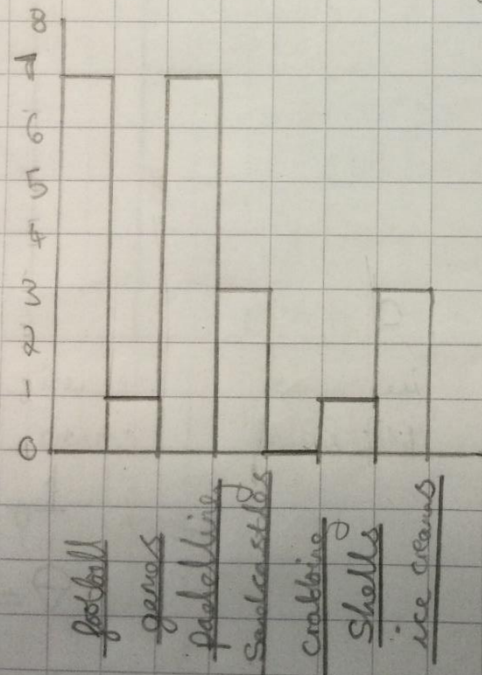
Pictogram to show choice of seaside dessert.

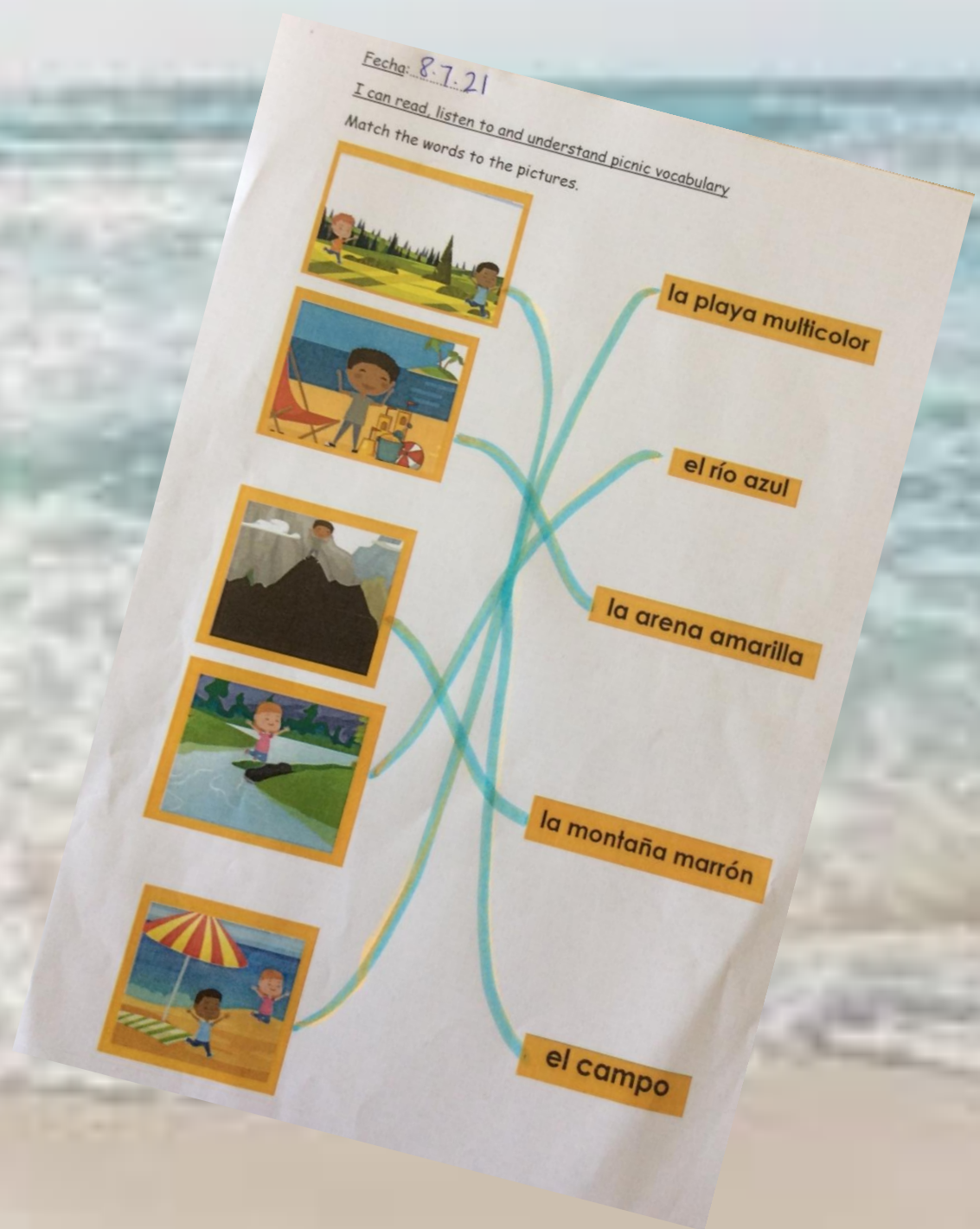




# SPANISH

We all make mistakes sometimes.



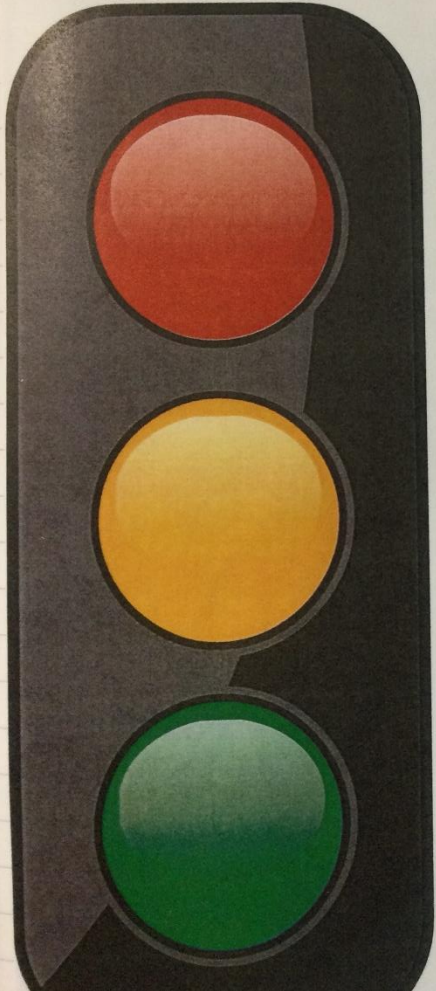
# R.H.E.

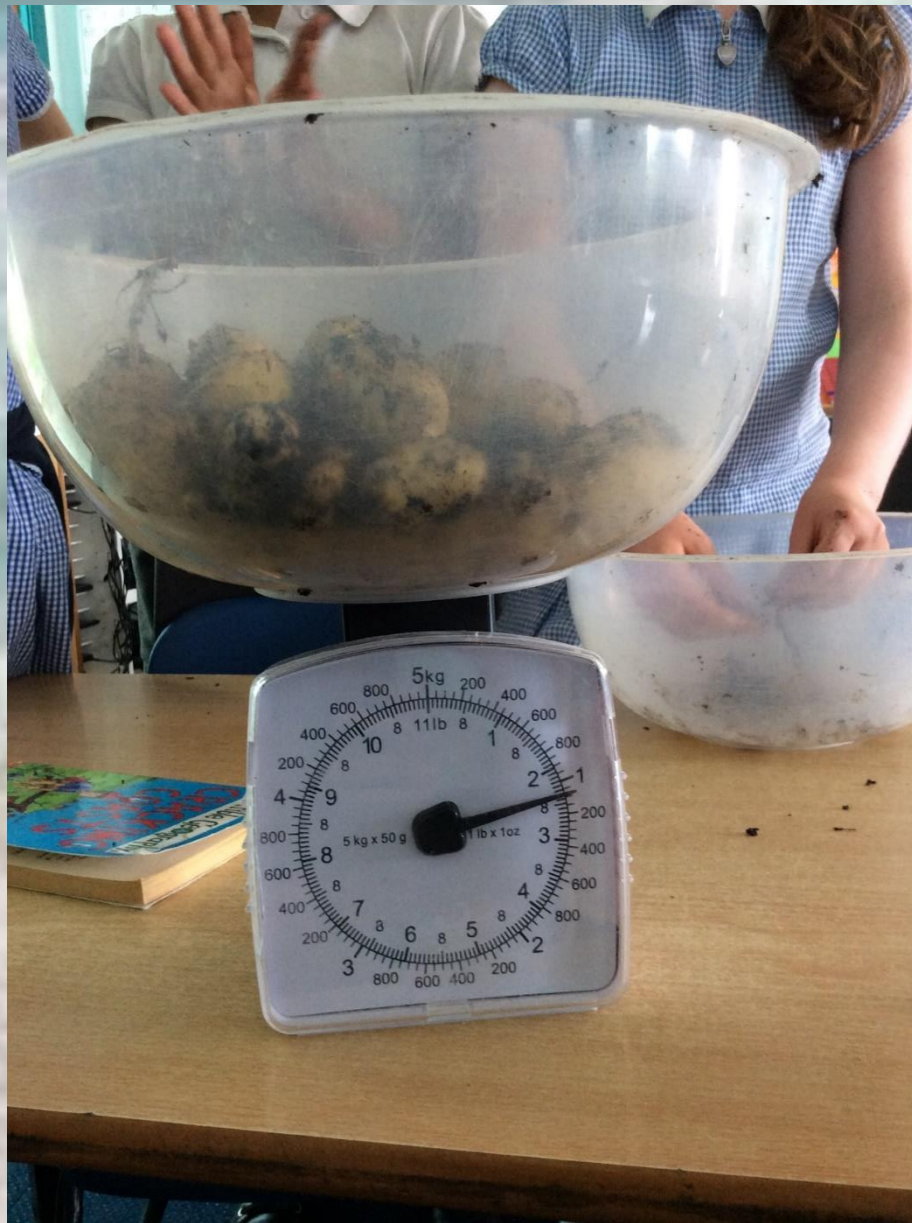
# Gardening Club
