







We have also learnt about addition and subtraction. We have also made fact families.

We also learnt to use a number line to help us when subtracting 2 digit and 1 digit numbers,














We then learnt to use base ten and a number line to help us when learning to add 1 digit and 2 digit numbers together.










The children used their own ideas to come up with a different naughty toy! We have created our own books to tell the story of what our naughty toys got up to!





Y2 English

Science










The local fire service visited and told us more about the history of the fire service and fire marks.

This half term we have thought about the question 'What does Christmas mean to Christians?'.


We have explored the Christmas Story, Christian Christmas traditions and thankfulness.
