# Letters and Sounds 'Phase 1'

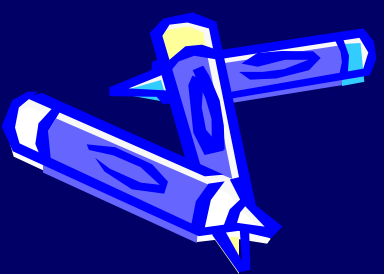
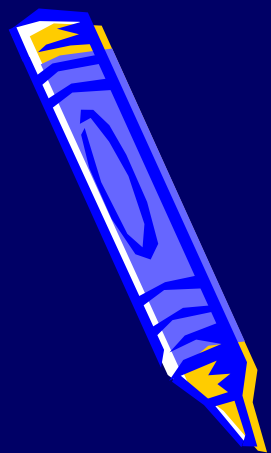


- Continues throughout and involves:

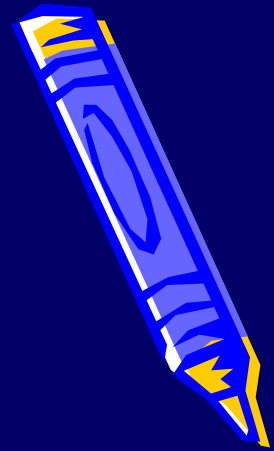

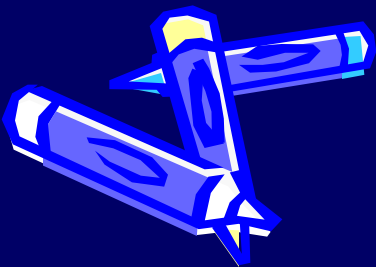

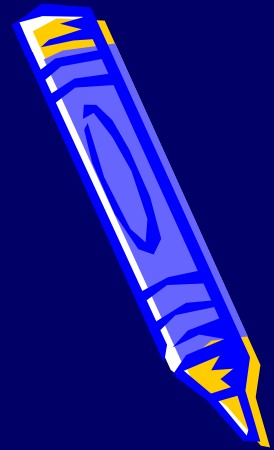
