- promoting and supporting the NHS Veterans Mental Health service



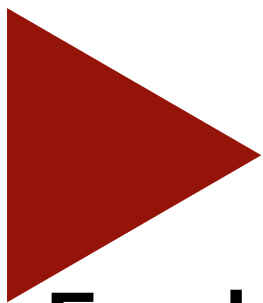
