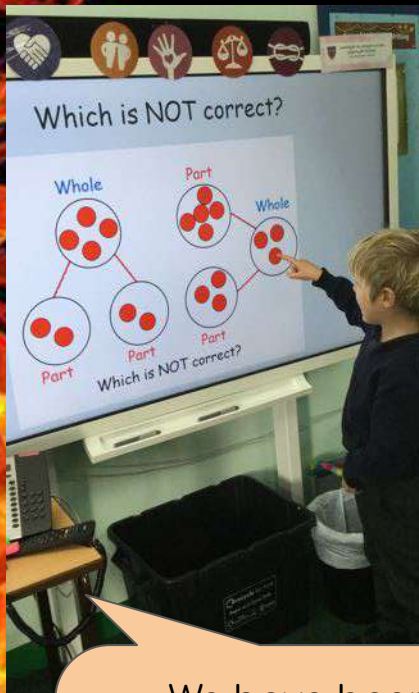

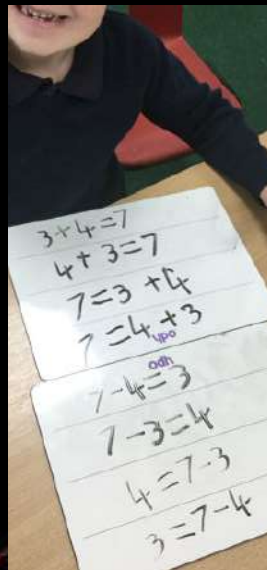
Y1 Maths

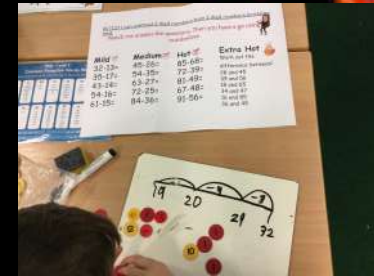
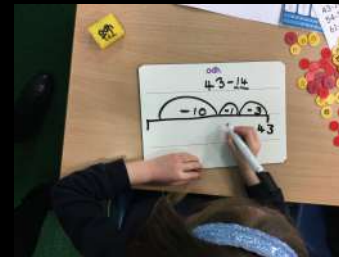

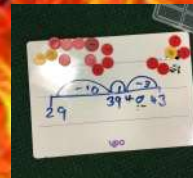
We have been learning about addition and subtraction. First, used tens frames to help us add by making ten.

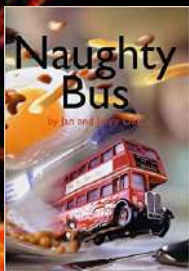

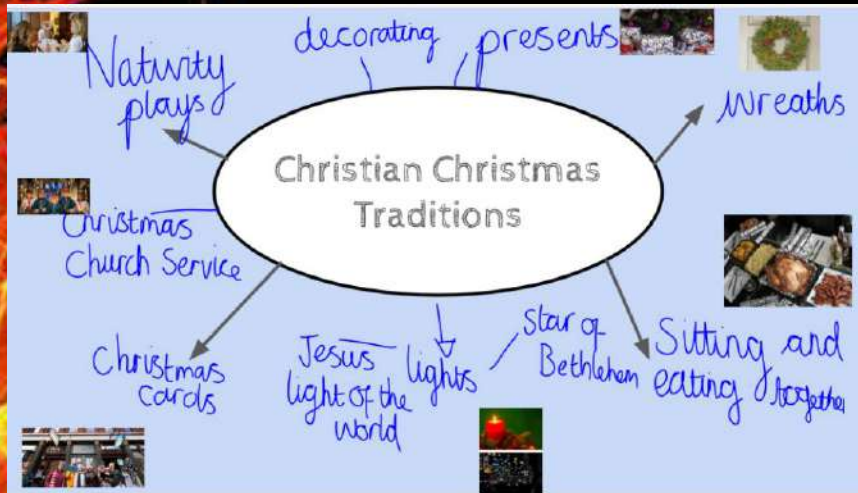


The local fire service visited and told us more about the history of the fire service and fire marks.

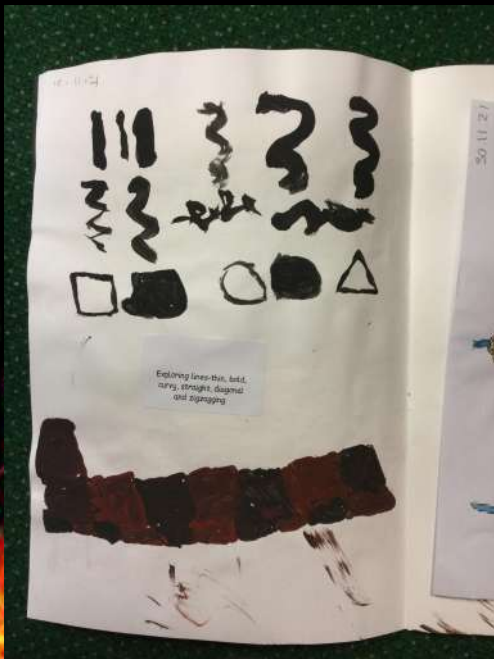
We have had two very exciting visits from our local fire fighters. We have learnt all about fire engines in the past and present. We designed and created our own!
