Y1/2 Spring Term 2 2021-2022


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In Y1 English, we have loved reading the story 'The Storm Whale'.













We have also written our own riddles all about sea creatures.



In Y2 maths, we have been learning to divide! We have used drawings to help us with this. Recently, we have begun learning about fractions using division to help us. In science, we have enjoyed learning about microhabitats. We learnt this is a small home.





We learnt animals which eat plants for their diet are herbivores, those which eat meat are carnivores and those which eat plants and meat are omnivores. We then used a venn diagram to sort the different underwater animals to identify and group them.




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We have been learning about the 5 oceans in geography this half term.

This term, in our RE lessons we have been learning about Lent and Easter. We enjoyed a visit from YoYo who taught us the Easter story. We have also learnt about Islam.
















The children have really enjoyed learning about another religion and have compared the similarities and differences between mosques and churches.
