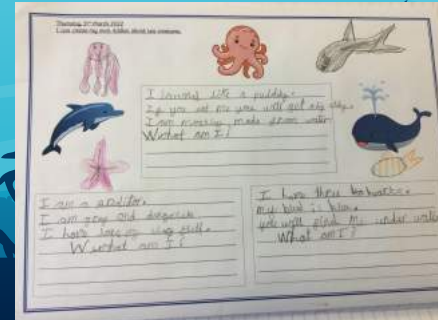
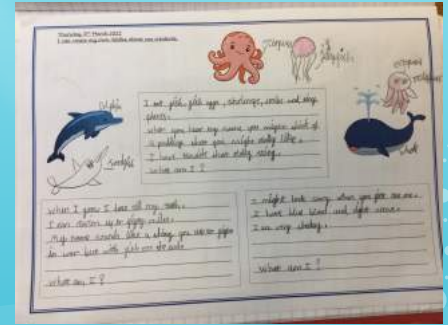
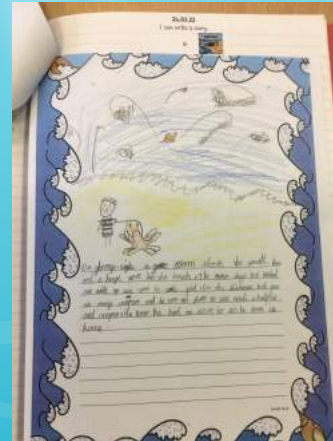
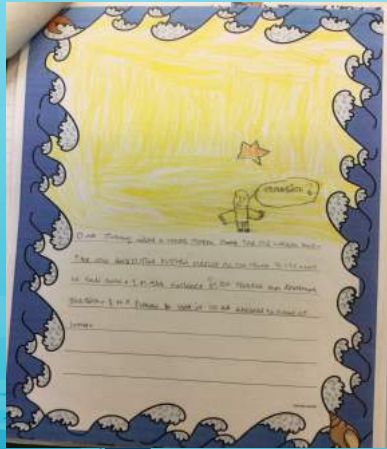
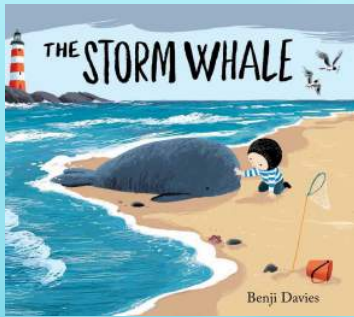


In Y1 English, we have loved reading the story 'The Storm Whale'.



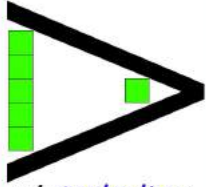

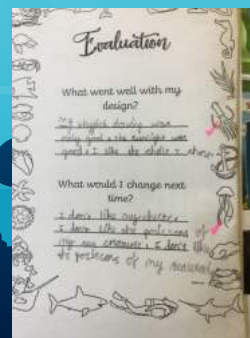
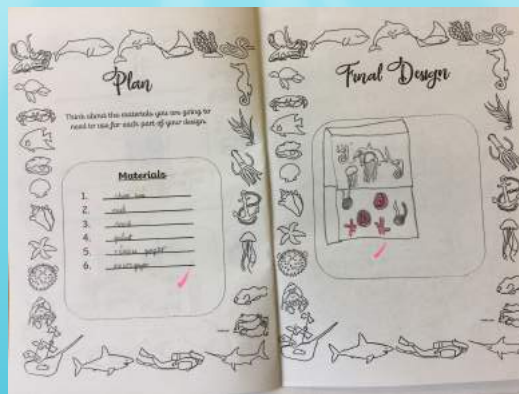
In Y2 maths, we have been learning to divide! We have used drawings to help us with this. Recently, we have begun learning about fractions using division to help us.

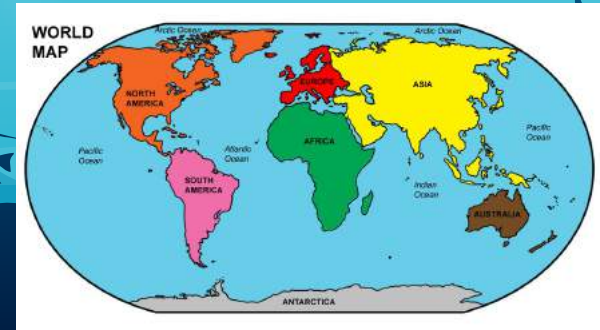
We have been learning about the 5 oceans in geography this half term.



We listened to the 5 oceans song to help us remember them all!

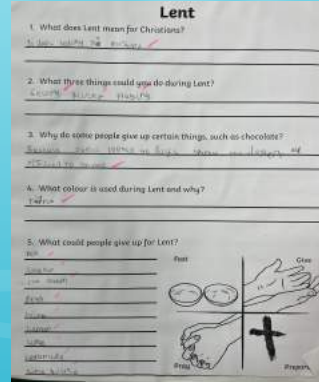
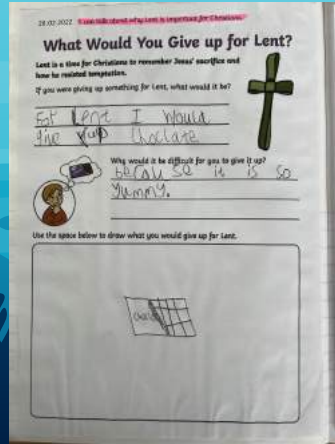
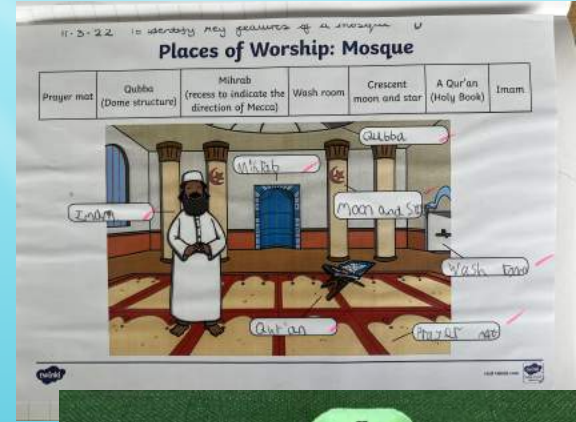
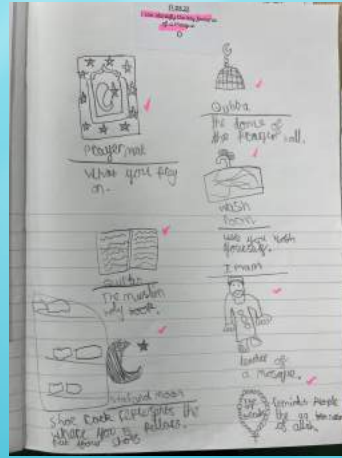
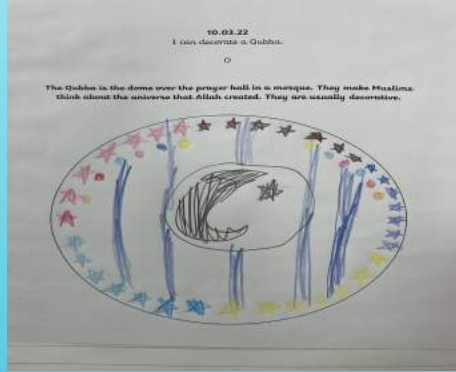


We have looked at all 5 oceans and learnt facts about each one, including what animals are found there.

The children have really enjoyed learning about another religion and have compared the similarities and differences between mosques and churches.

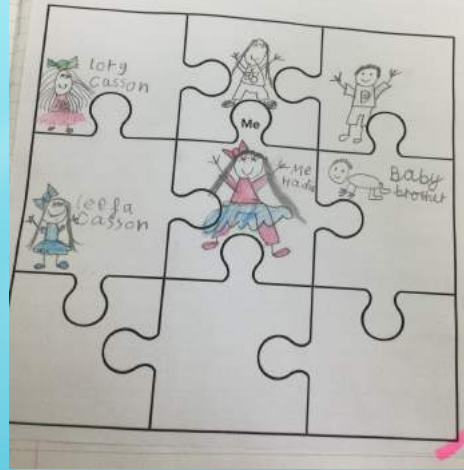

In our RHE lessons, we have been learning about families. We have thought about what makes a family, different types of families and our own families. We thought about what our family members are super at.

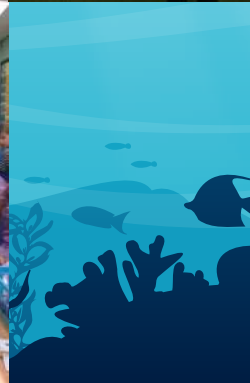
