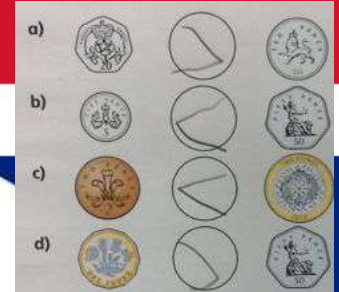
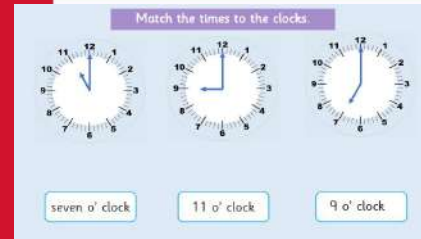
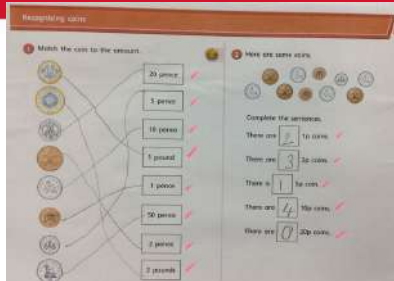
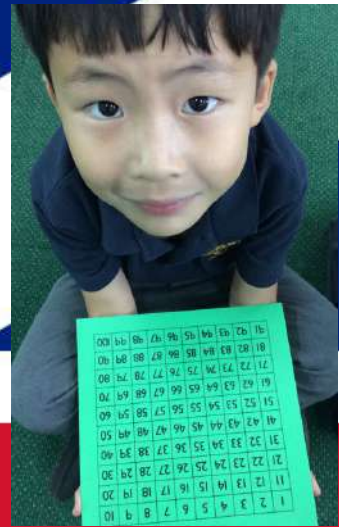
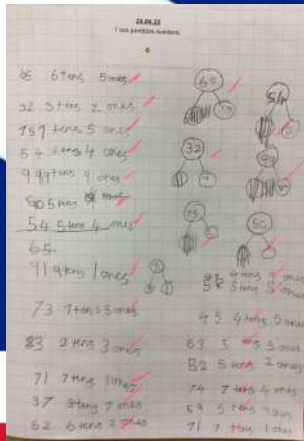
English

This half term in maths we have been looking at measuring height, weight and volume. We have also looked at describing position, direction and turns.



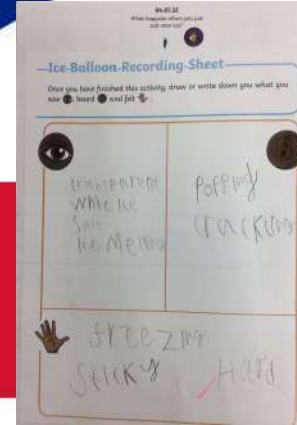

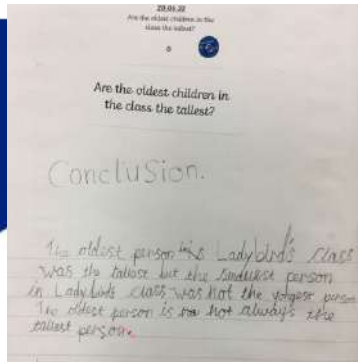

Religious Education



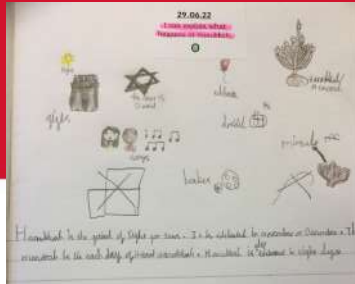
We learnt what a mezuzah is. We then designed our own.



We learnt about challah bread, the menorah and how a yad is used.

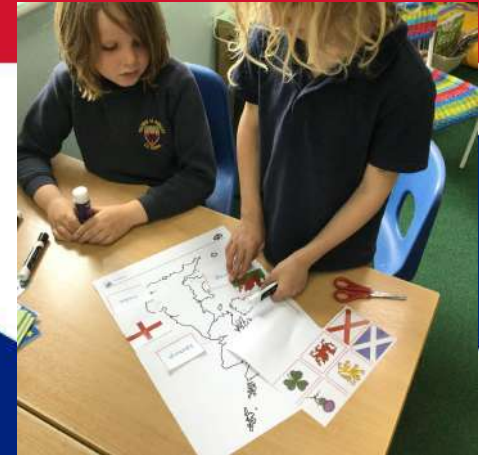
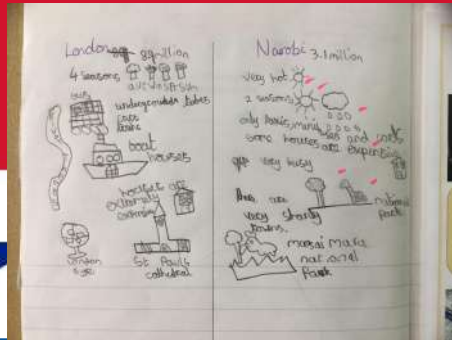
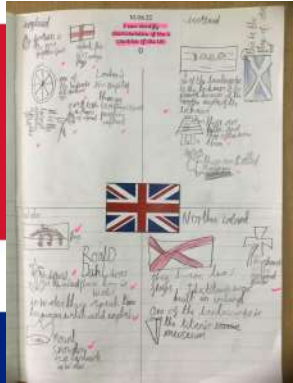


We created posters to show Shabbat is celebrated.

This half term in music we have been looking at African music. We have enjoyed playing the african drums and glockenspiels.

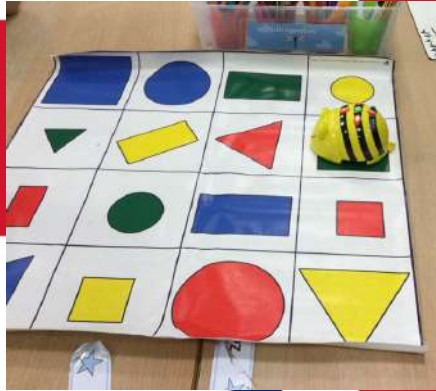
We began in computing by following instructions to draw a picture.

This half term, we have been learning about algorithms.

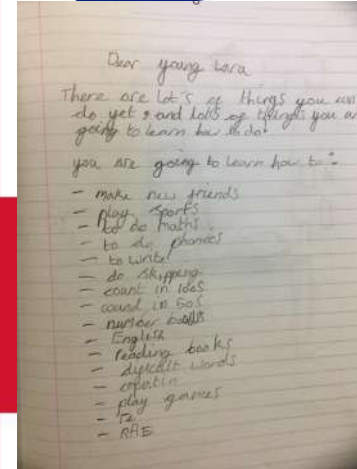


RHE

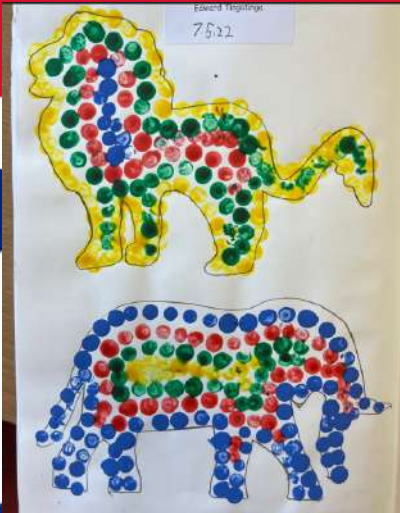
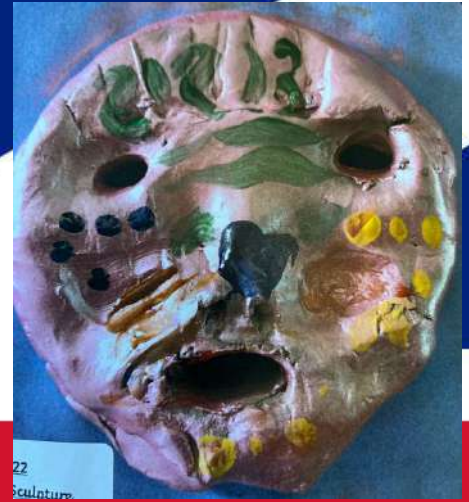
This half term in RHE we have been talking about changes and looking ahead to the future.

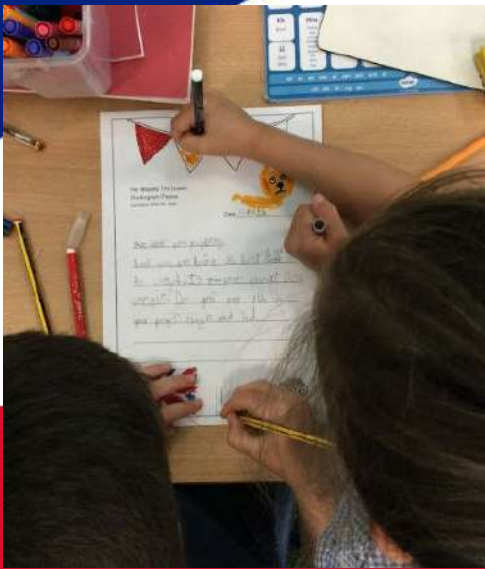
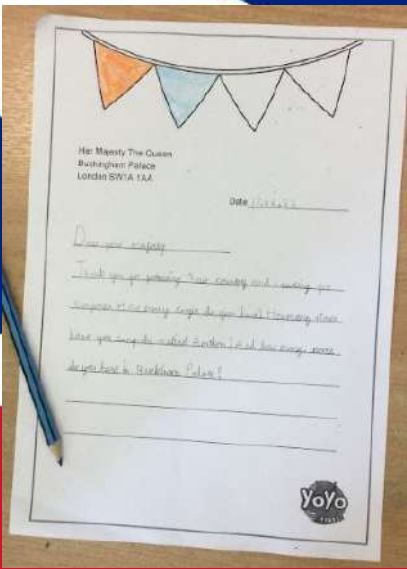
