

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

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




Year 1 Maths







This half term in maths we have been looking at place value (within 100), money and time.

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







This half term in maths we have been looking at measuring height, weight and volume. We have also looked at describing position, direction and turns.










Geography







In Geography we have been looking at the 4 countries of the UK and the surrounding seas. We looked at the UK on an atlas and compared life in the UK to life in Kenya.










We had such fun competing in our sports morning. The children ran races, pulled themselves along a beam and completed some throwing activities. We were so proud of how the children encouraged one another.


