






Learning in Reception Summer Term 1





Ten Little Pirates


This half term, we read *Ten Little Pirates* and learned lots of new vocabulary about pirates.

We have learned about the value of trust. In our collective worship we have talked about who we can trust and how we can be trustworthy




We are getting really good at sharing, taking turns, listening to each other's ideas



We have been thinking about and valuing the things that make us special






Literacy

We have learned to write for lots of different purposes – maps, non-fiction, story endings and story maps are a few










Maths


We have learned about odd and even numbers, sequencing and ordering numbers and looking at different ways to compose numbers.
















Understanding the World







Summer 2 in Reception

The value we have thought about this half term has been justice. We have thought about when things are fair or unfair and what we can do about it...






Physical Development

We continue to develop our skills and confidence with our fine and gross motor skills, using our equipment inside and out....








Literacy

Maths


















We have practised our maths skills inplay and in our daily maths sessions. We have explored symmetry and what words we can use to compare length and height. We use numbers to play games and to work out problems.
