























In science, we have been learning about the human body. We have learnt about the different senses, part of the human body and how to stay healthy.

In music we looked at how we can make music using our bodies. We then thought about our emotions and how different instruments, tempos and pitches can represent them. Finally we learnt a skeleton song!


















Pick a card then pick an instrument and think about how you would play that instrument to show that emotion.

- Kind words




We have also discussed personal boundaries and things that may make us worried and ways in which to a share our worries with the people we trust.

We've looked at toys over the past 100 years, how we know about them and how and why they have changed over time.










We really enjoyed playing games and with toys that were popular a long time ago!


















We had some special visitors come in and teach us all about the toys that they had and played with in the past! It was very interesting!

In DT this half term, we have designed and made paper toys. We thought about what makes a toy enjoyable and then created our own.




















My toy had bright colours.
























We also learnt about what it means to be healthy and how to look after our bodies. We designed and made our very own fruit kebabs. They were delicious!
