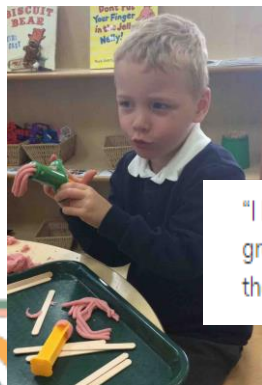
Our first half term at school
