We have had loads of fun celebrating British Science Week. Here we are wearing vision altering goggles and seeing how our brains learn to adapt.

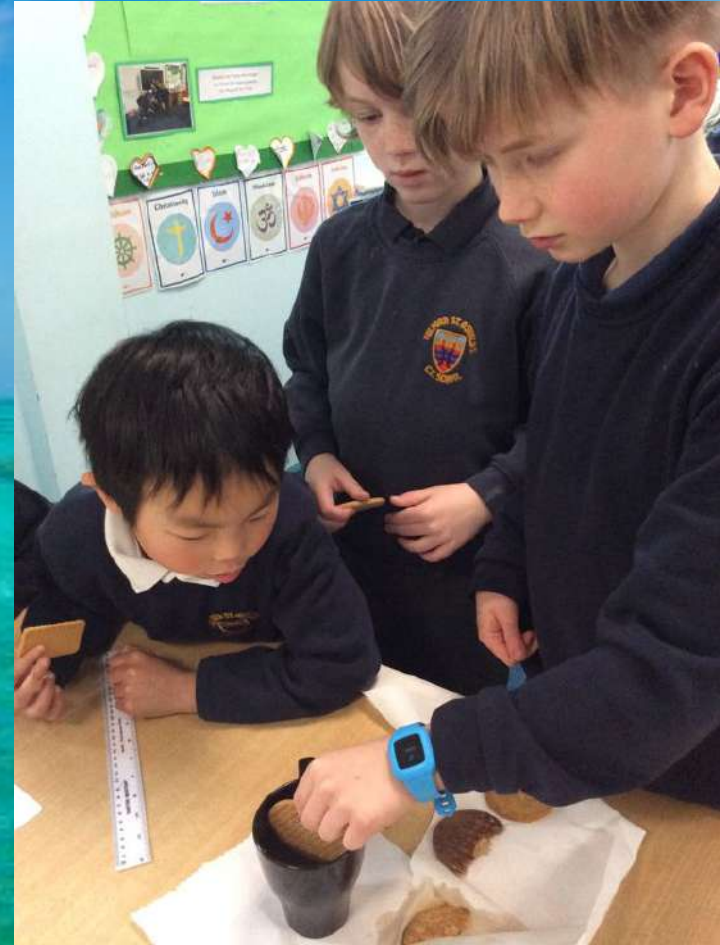






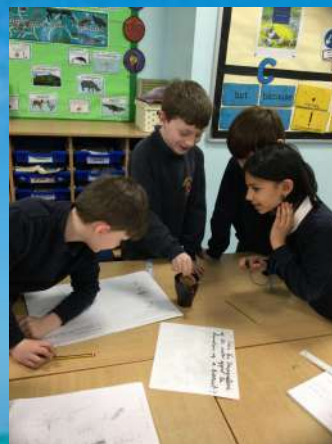


We also joined in the whole school with biscuit dunking! We investigated to see if the thickness of the biscuit affected the dunkability.

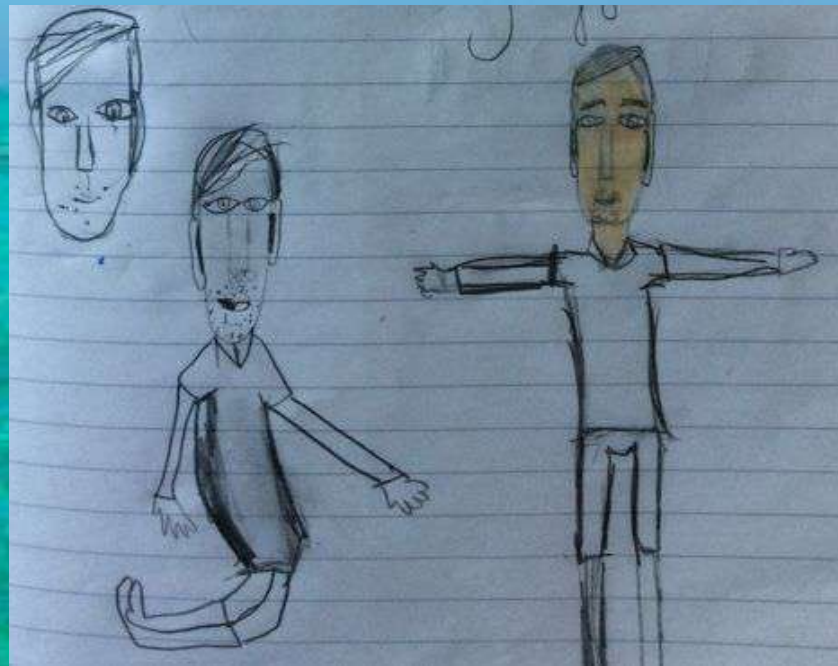
Although he ~~does~~ <sup>do</sup> have a square and fat

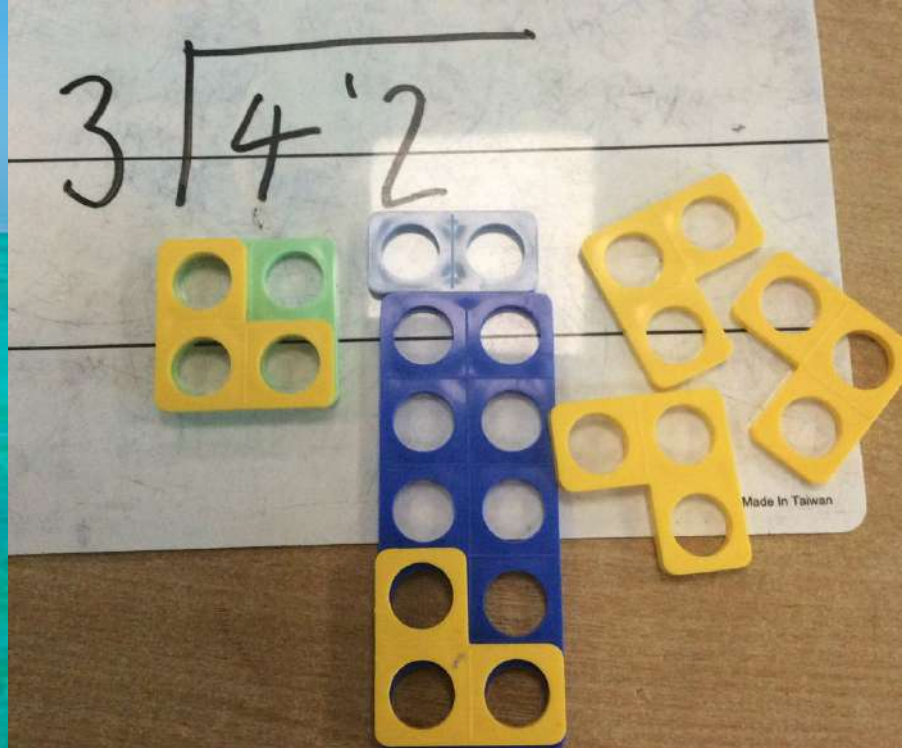
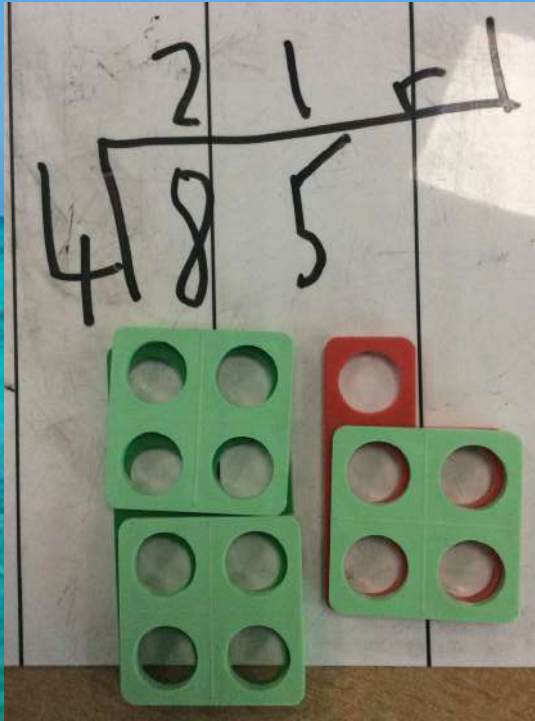

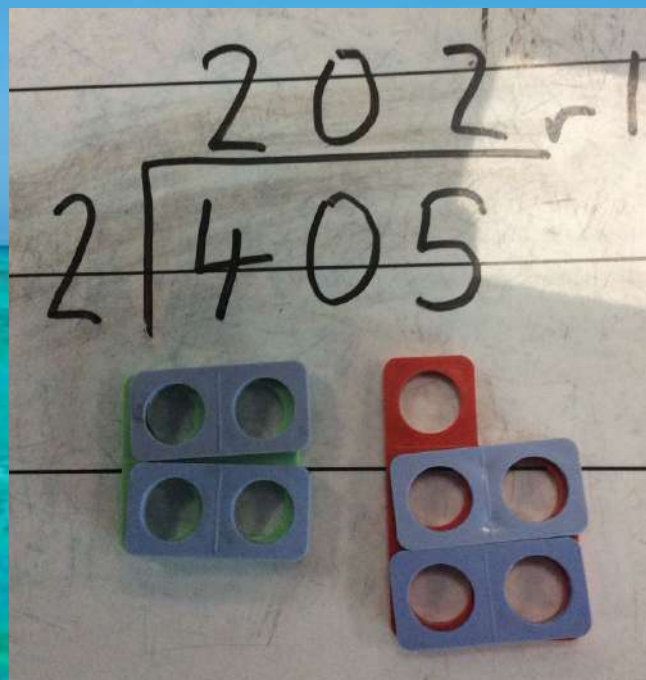




In Year 4 Maths, we have been dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by one digit numbers.

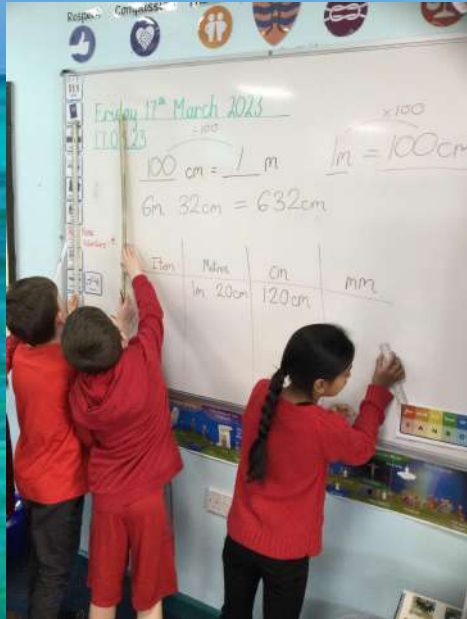






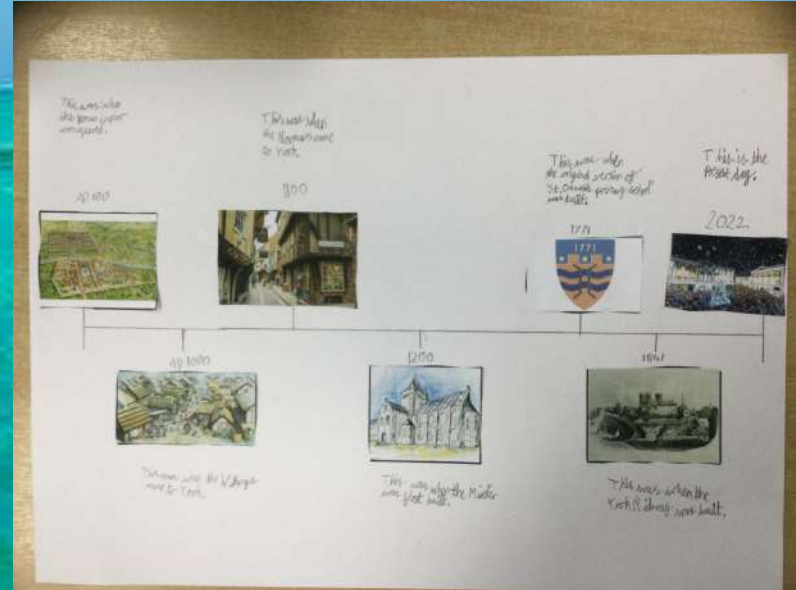


In Year 3 maths, we have been learning to measure and convert measurements from metres, into centimetres and millimetres.

Accepted that he was going to die.

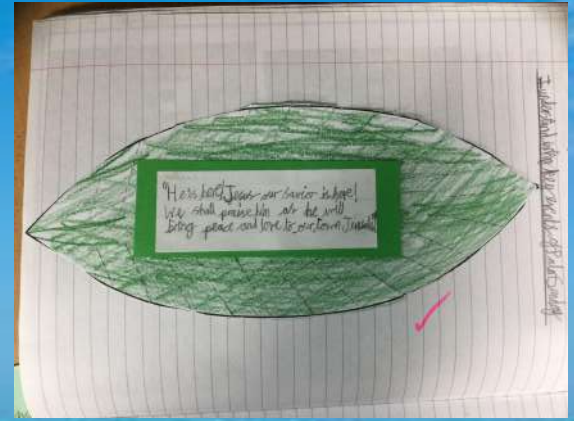
Jesus taught people to not be afraid of death.

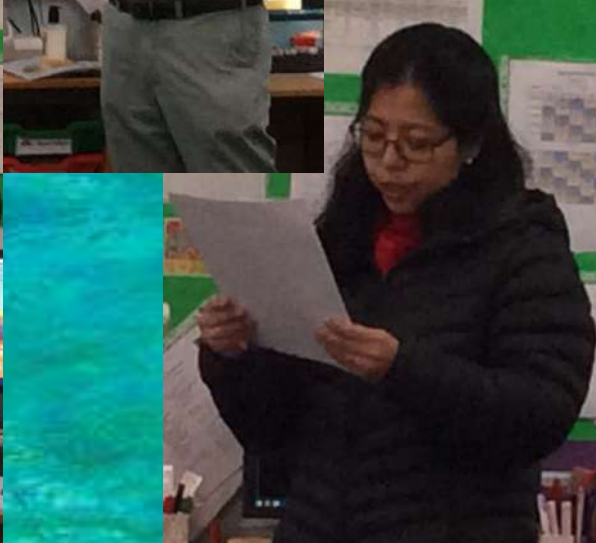
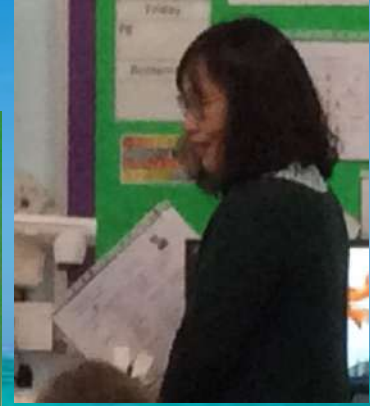
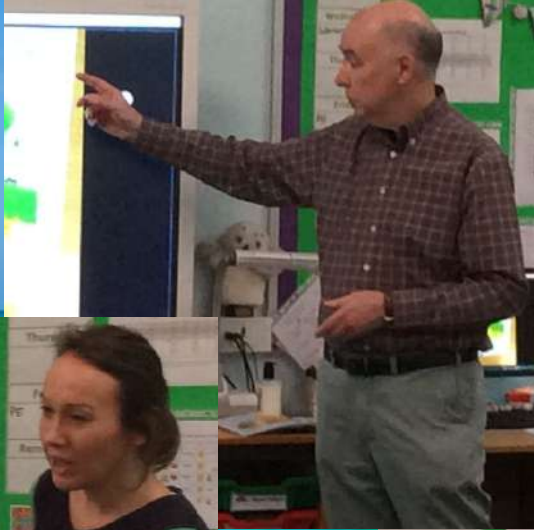

We also heard stories read to us in Dutch, Chinese, Welsh, Burmese, Mandarin, French and Chichewa from some of our family members!



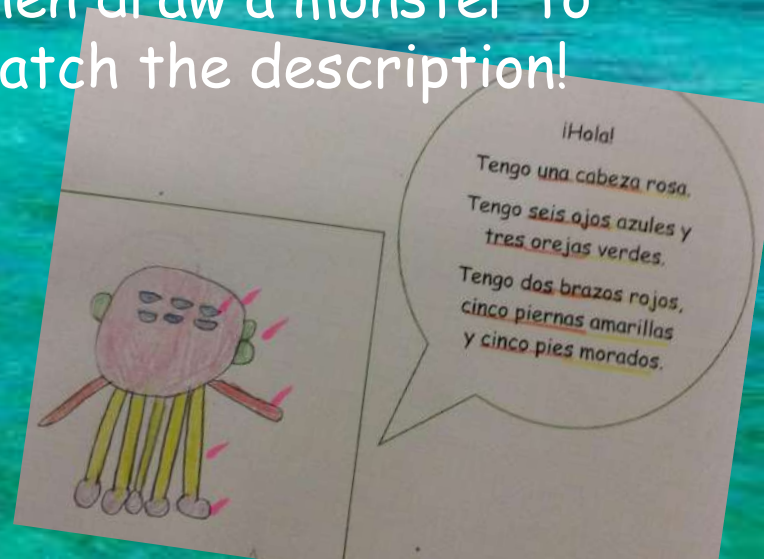
