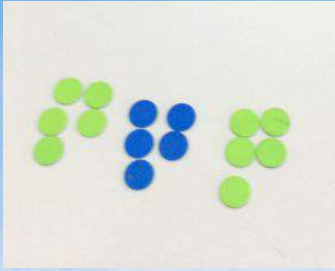

Y1 Maths

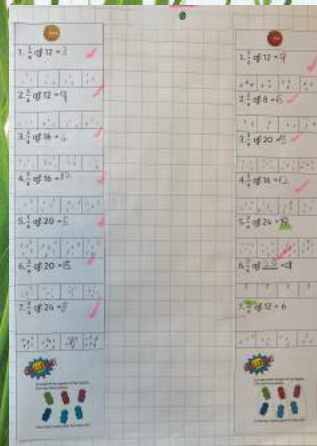
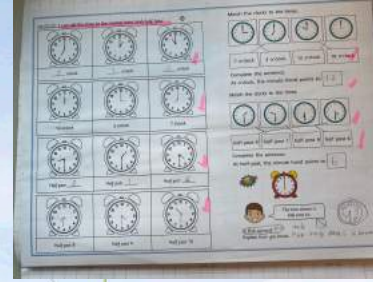
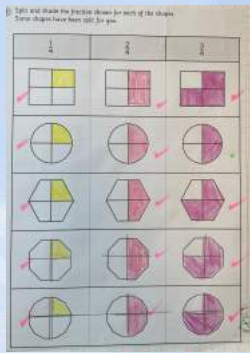
The children really loved learning about the measures part of the curriculum. We measure the length and height of objects in blocks and centimetres. For mass we used blocks to compare the mass of objects. In capacity we worked outside using water to measure the capacity of containers.



In number work we have learnt to count in 2's, 5's and 10's. We have made equal groups in different ways and looked at arrays to make counting easier. We have learnt how to find a half and quarter of shapes/objects and of a quantity.



Y2 Maths



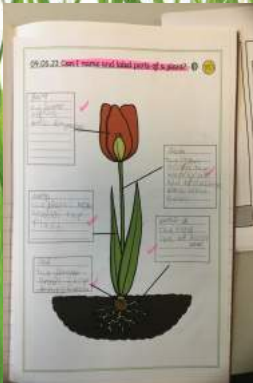
In Y2 maths, we continued to learn about fractions of amounts. We then learnt to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

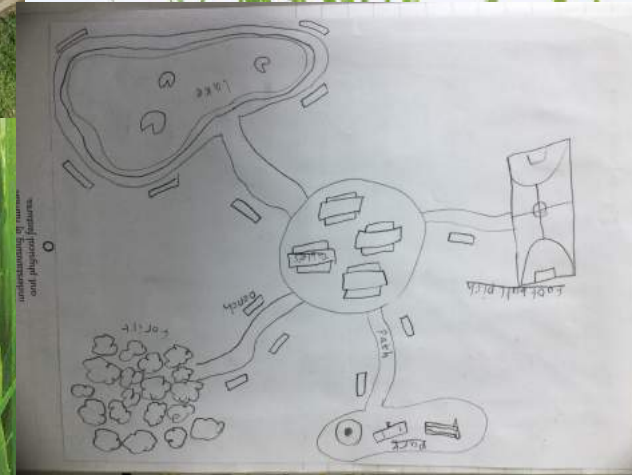
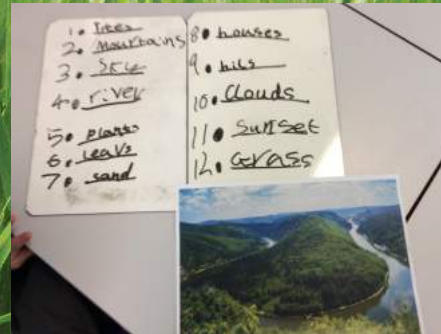
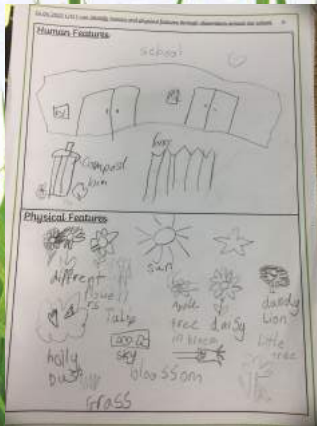

We then looked at plan perspectives and designed our own setting from a plan perspective, and made sure to include human and physical features.



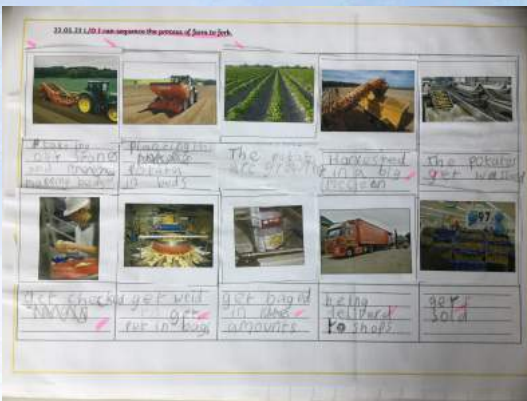
Where does our food come from?

Computing

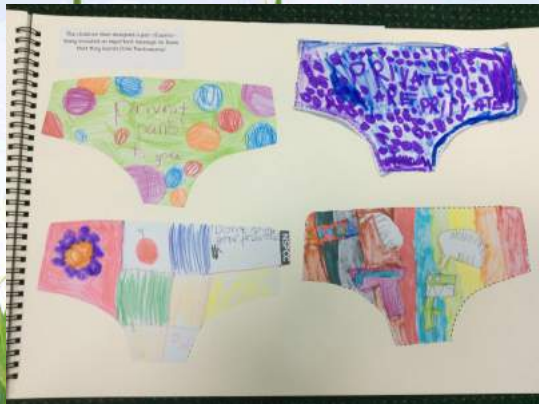

Helpful or harmful?



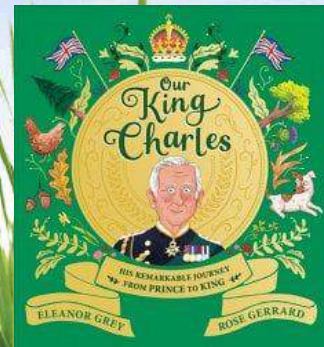
In one of our lessons, we talked about the helpful and harmful items we may have in our houses for when we are feeling unwell.
