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
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


We then read the story Jim and The Beanstalk. We made predictions then imagined we climbed the beanstalk and wrote character descriptions.






We have also been learning about weight and mass. We looked at using scales to weight objects in grams.

Pause . . . ask 'What do you think he did?


He asked for a knife. Carefully he cut around his cloak where the cat and her kittens were lying and then without disturbing them he walked quietly away


