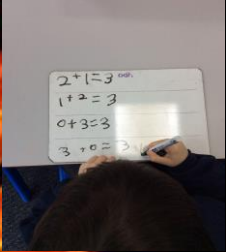

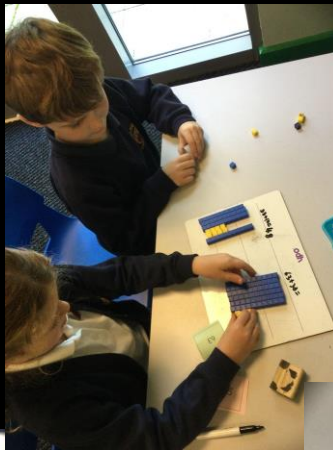
Y1 Maths

We have been looking at addition and subtraction this half term. We have used our number knowledge up to 10 to calculate with confidence.

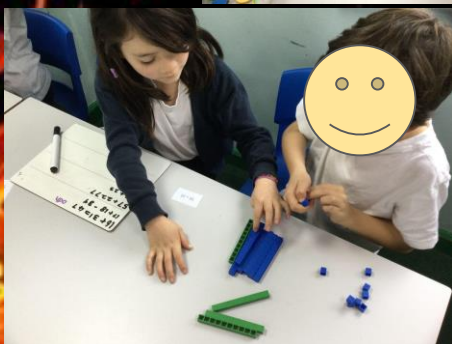
We have been looking at addition and subtraction this half term. We have used our knowledge of related facts and number bonds to 10 to find bonds to 100

We have added and subtracted two 2-digit numbers using a variety of methods.



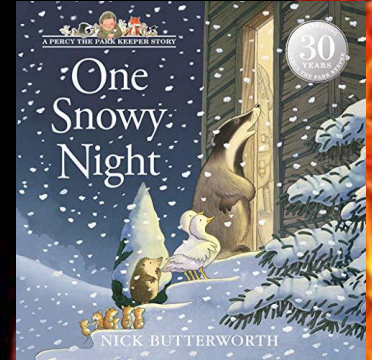
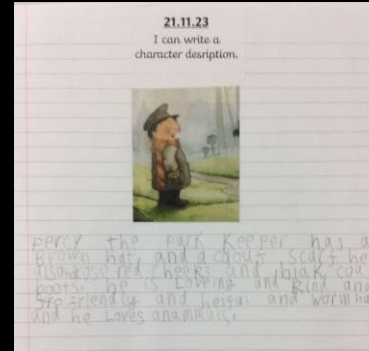
We looked at all things

In Science, we have been looking at different materials and their suitability.

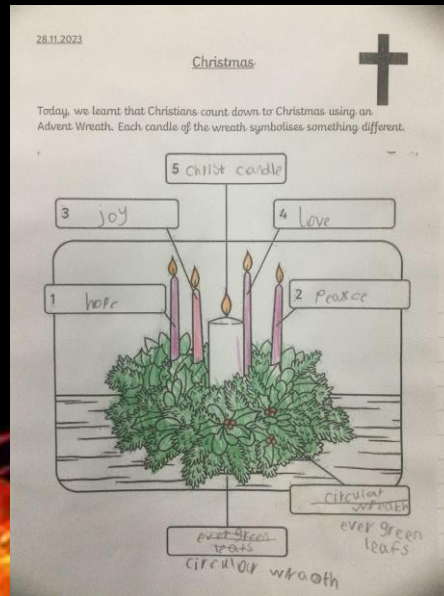
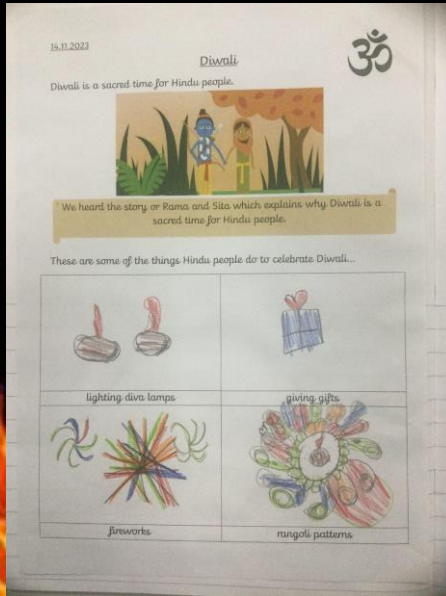


Science

In R.E this half term, we have been thinking about special and sacred times. We started off thinking about a time that is special to us. We enjoyed sharing photos of special times with our classmates!

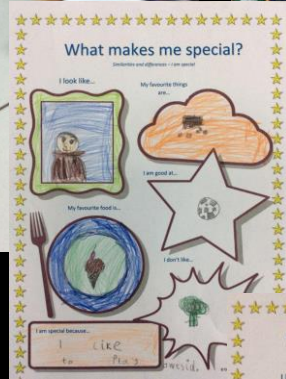

We explored what it means to be and feel different and why we should celebrate how we all have different strengths.



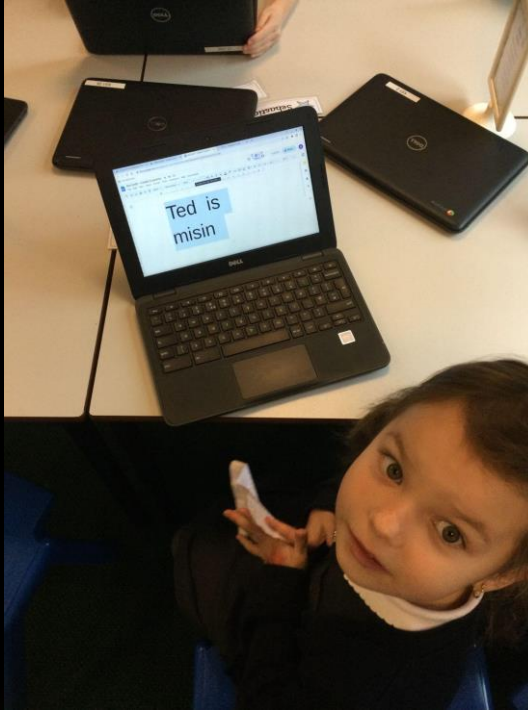

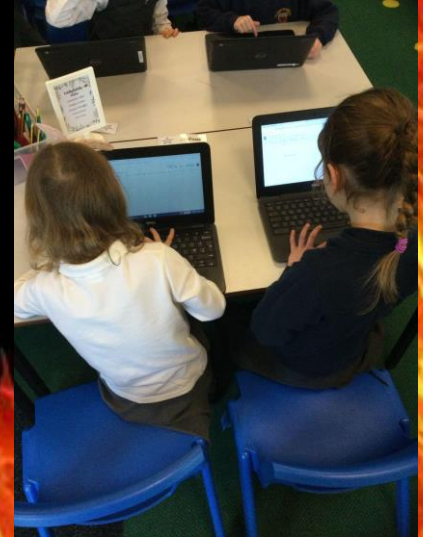
Computing

We looked at axles and wheels to make our engines move. We used a saw to cut through the dowelling.



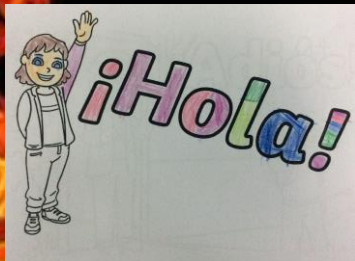
In Art and Design, we have been developing our painting skills.

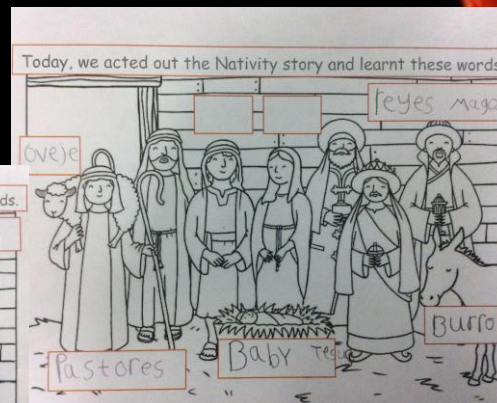

We really enjoyed our Box2BFit experience, where we completed circuit training. We visited different stations where we challenged ourselves to keep going for 2 minutes at each station.

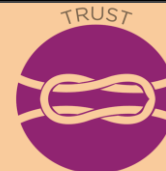
With Mr Sellers we have been learning all about striking and hitting. We have had a go at golf and hockey.
