### Learning for all

Last term ended with a series of celebratory events that reflected how far our pupils have come over the course of the autumn term. We are now operating a **start time of 8.45am**. Gates to the playground continue to open at 8.30am, with doors opening at 8.40am and will now close promptly at 8.45am. **Any arrivals after 8.45am** will need to enter school through the Front Office. End times will continue to be staggered with reception at 3.05pm, KS1 at 3.10pm and KS2 at 3.15pm. Please could we encourage you to be on time collecting your child, as this impacts teachers' ability to attend meetings which are often booked directly after the school day.

All parents and carers are welcome to join us each Friday this term for collective worship at 9am. On **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January at 10am**, there will be a commissioning service held in the school hall, which takes place when a new headteacher takes up post in a church school. Parents and carers are most welcome to join us for the occasion.

### Caring for each other

We are continuing to look at ways to improve the entryway in/out of school as we know it is a tight squeeze during the start and end of day. In the meantime, could we ask that all families try to walk on the left side of the path to allow passing space for others. Thank you.

### Reminders from previous newsletters:

Places at our Night Owls after-school club are very popular, with certain nights of the week booking up very quickly far in advance. **If you have booked a space that you no longer need, please contact the school office as soon as possible** so that we can make the place available for another child to use. Any bookings that are cancelled 24-hours in advance, will be refunded. We have also expanded our extra-curricular provision to try and provide other activities on the evenings that are most in demand with our families and have proved to be very popular. We have several families that rely heavily on the disabled car parking spaces in the school car park. Unfortunately, these are still often being taken by drivers without disabled parking badges. Please can I ask you to show due care by parking your car elsewhere and leaving these spaces for those who need them most. Careless parking also poses a very real danger to our children leaving school on an afternoon, and we have had some near misses reported to the school office. If you are able to, please walk to school and if not, consider other places to park outside of the car park if it is full.

For safety, bikes are not to be used in the playground at drop off and pick up time.

### Preparing for the future

We have many exciting opportunities planned for the children over the coming term to enrich their learning and stretch their horizons. Our KS2 choir will be performing at the Young Voices concert in Sheffield; our new Y6 Debate Club will be visiting London's Houses of Parliament; Purple Pig Farm will be visiting Early Years and Zoolab visiting Year 3/4; KS1 and Year 5/6 pupils will be visiting The Deep and Magna respectively.
