






















We read the story Jack and the Beanstalk. We wrote retellings and descriptions whilst studying each story.








In English, we wrote our own instruction for a range of different outcomes.

We also look at how plants survive in different habitats around the world.




How do Muslims show they belong? We considered ways that Muslims show that they belong within their religion. We then compared the differences between how Christians and
