
Incredible Journeys

Year 3/4 2025 Summer Term 1



We have been learning about sound in our science lessons! We experimented with instruments what different pitch and dynamics we could make. We learned that sound is caused by vibrations.





In RHE, we looked at 'Healthy Choices'.






We also did some drama work showing our school values in action.













During RE lessons, we have been looking at what different people believe about God. We compared the beliefs of Muslims and Hindus.



Eastings and Northings



All the grid lines are numbered to help find specific areas on the map.


Eastings are the numbers than run from left to right on the map.






We have played lots of speaking and listening games. Here we are playing Quiz Quiz Swap.





straws.





We made bridges using cross-bracing, triangulation and corrugation designs.






In PE, we have been practising our athletics and strike and field skills.
