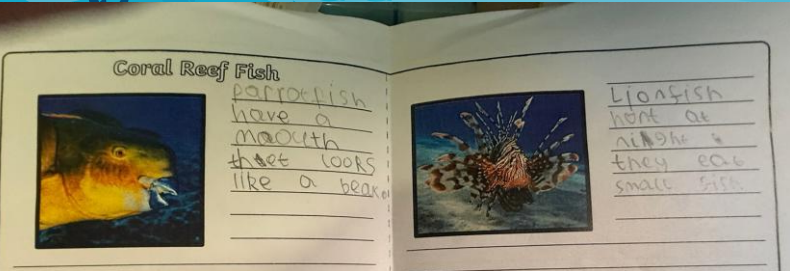
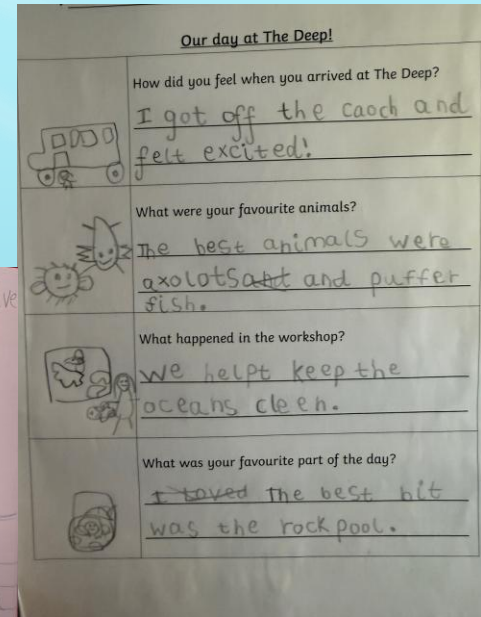
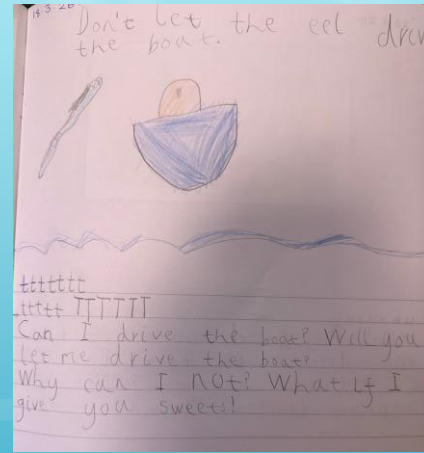
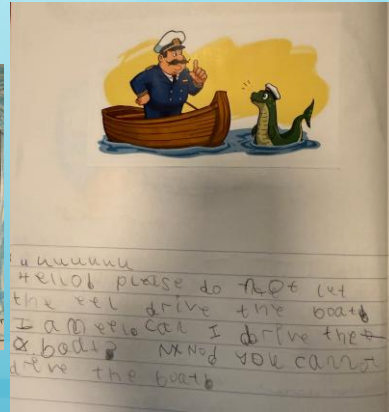
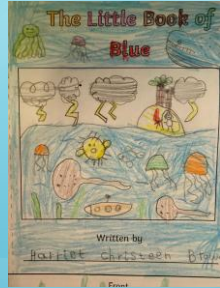
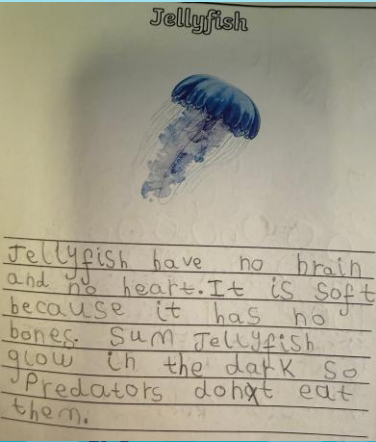


Y1/2 Spring Term 2 2025-2026

In Butterflies class, we wrote a recount of our trip to The Deep.

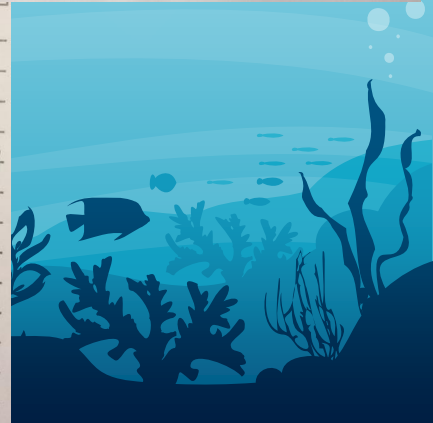
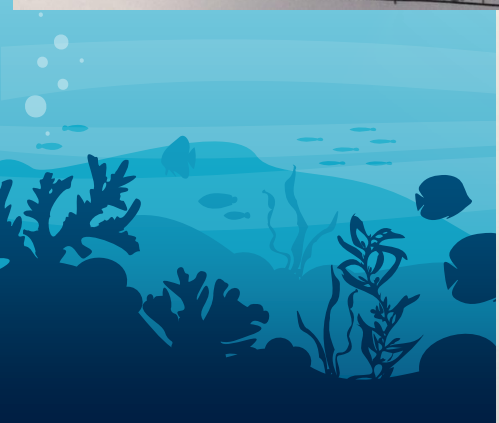


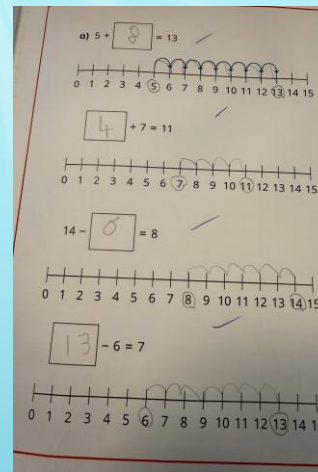
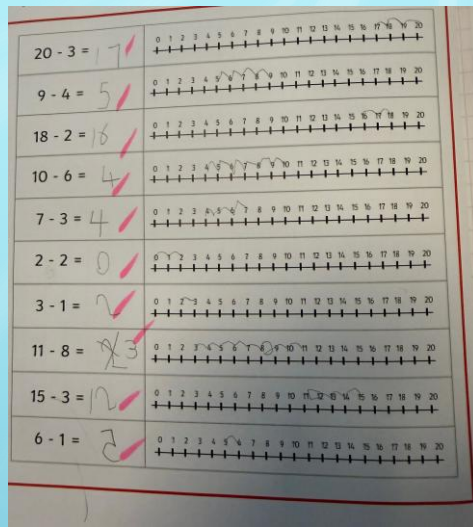
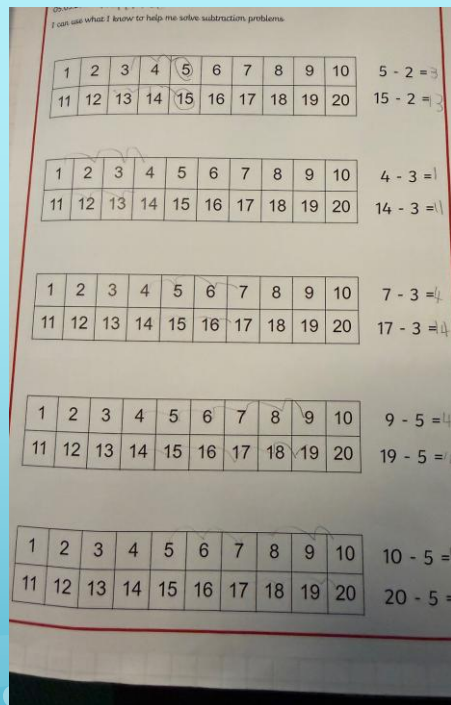
my favourite fish was the unicorn fish and the gold fish. I think it was wonderful. I wish we could stay for one more hour. in the time this been

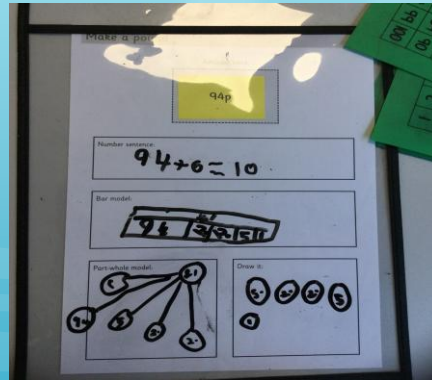
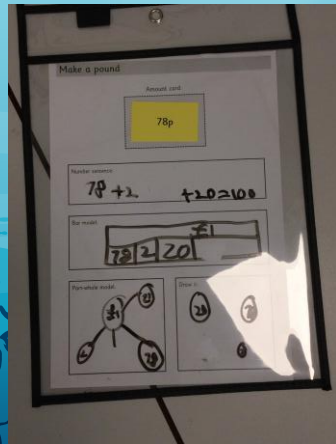
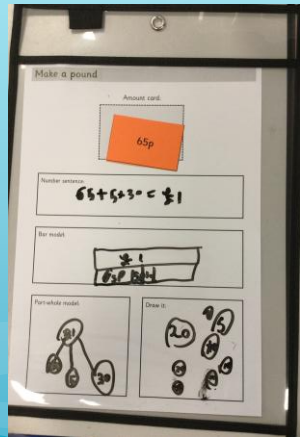
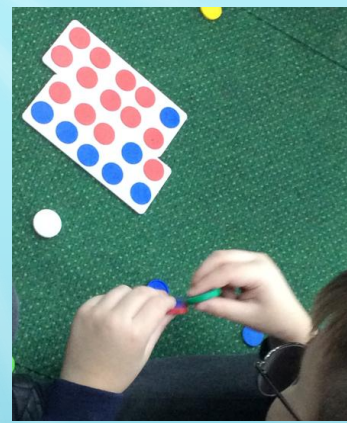
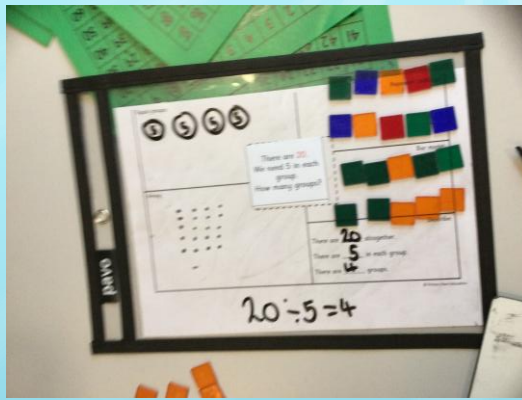


We used estimating to place numbers on a number line and found doubles by calculating mentally.

We have added and subtracted numbers on a number line too!

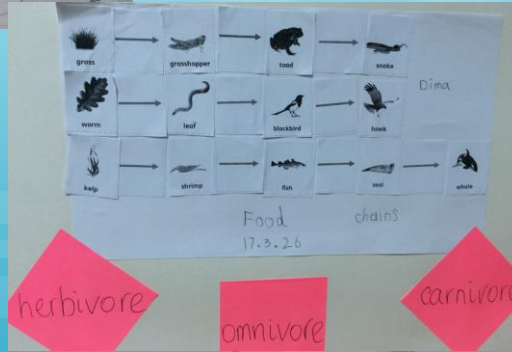
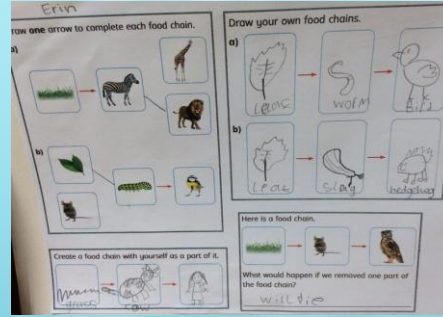
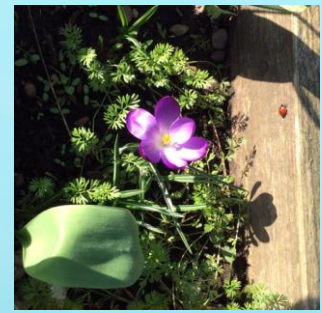


In Y1 maths, we have been learning about numbers up to 20. We have compared, ordered and partitioned different numbers to show our understanding of each number's value.

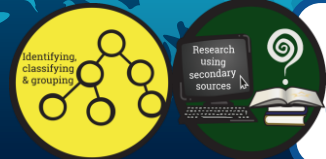


In Y2 maths, we have been learning how to multiply and divide, using our knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

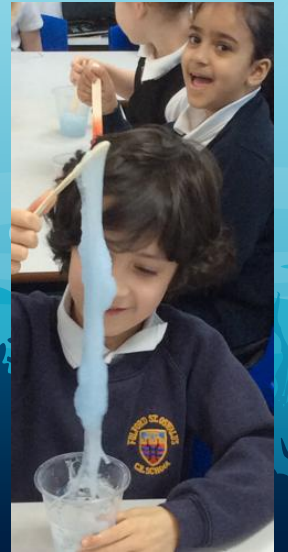
In science, we have enjoyed learning about different habitats, how they have adapted to live in different climates and food chains.

We also had great fun celebrating British Science Week with lots of exciting experiments and investigations going on in school all week.

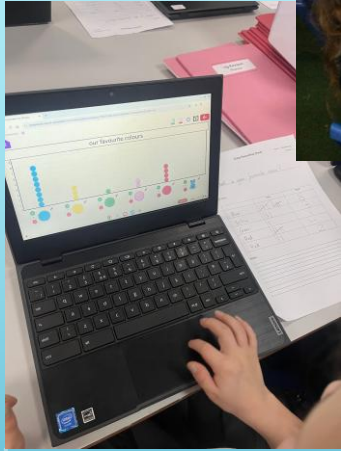


We were very lucky to have Rohan's mum come and visit us for the morning and help us make slime. We learnt how to think like scientists and ask lots of good questions.

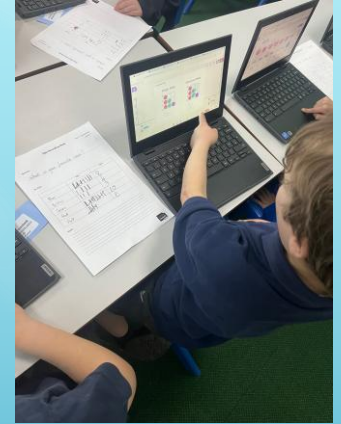
In our computing lessons, we have continued to learn how to use pictograms.

In our RHE lessons, we have been learning about why our families are important.

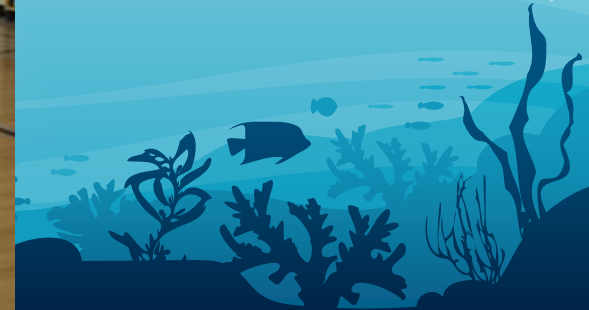


We discussed how every family is different and how we all do different things together with our families. We ordered our favourite activities and shared them with our friends.



We shared how our families help each other and identified superhero family members!

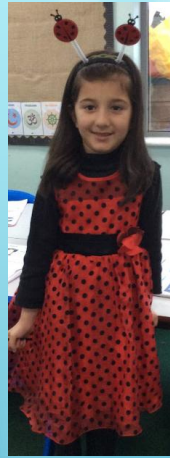
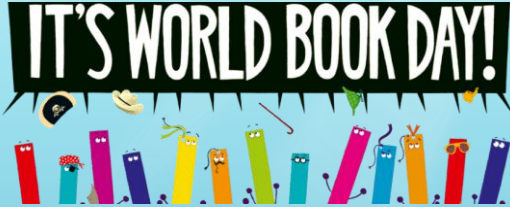
In PE we have continued to learn about team games and developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.
